NEW YORK-LONDON AIR ROUTE READY Experimental Flights Begin Tomorrow; Regular Service Within Few Months.

New York, July 2.—(AP)—Commercial four-year study and surveys, Pan American Airways prepared a flying boat today for an "experimental" schedule flight to London as the forerunner to a regular passenger service across the Atlantic.

The British boat is H. M. A. Calcutta, commanded by Capt. A. R. W. Wilson, a veteran of the Royal Air Force. Four other men comprise the British crew.

Neither passengers nor mail will be carried by either ship. The crews will be occupied entirely with navigation and communications observations.

When the service becomes a reality, American aviators' commercial conquest of the world will be completed, with United States airlines in operation around approximately 16,000 miles of the globe's 24,000-mile girth.
