CONGRESS EXPECTS TO BE CALLED BACK

Leaders Look for a Special Session Although Many Members Oppose the Idea

Washington, Aug. 25.—(AP)—The capital—aside from President Roosevelt—accepted today as a virtual certainty a fall session of Congress to consider federal and wage legislation.

Mr. Roosevelt said he was considering the arguments for and against a special session, but had not made up his mind.

He conferred yesterday with Senator Barkley of Kentucky and Representative Rayburn of the Senate and House majority leaders, on the question.

Neither would comment afterwards on his probable decision. Mr. Barkley said he did not wish to "imply on his (Roosevelt's) part."

Other administration leaders, however, freely have predicted a special session, among them Speaker Clegg of the House and Senator Cuffey of the Senate.

An assembly of Democrats, including many who wished power to the White House, let it be known they were ready to support the idea.

They explained they were particularly eager to give the country an intra-party discussion, which grew into a debate on Supreme Court and wage-hour legislation, time to time.

This group also took the stand that none of the side-tracked legislation was of such pressing importance it could not wait until January.

SEE TRADE PACTS AS HOPE OF PEACE

Washington Officials Hold That Trade Barriers Prevent Concord of Nations

Washington, Aug. 25.—(AP)—High administration officials expressed the belief today that the world's chief hope for peace lies in eliminating trade barriers.

Without specific reference to conflicts in China and Spain, they said that restrictions on free commercial intercourse among the nations had prompted unsettled conditions in the last 18 months.

They said that the removal of trade barriers and limitation of arms would be the best way to bring about a permanent peace.

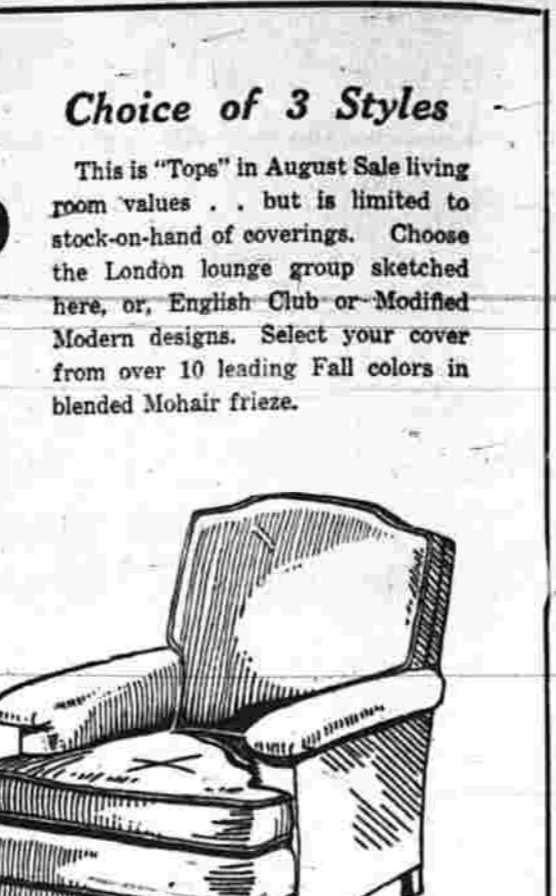

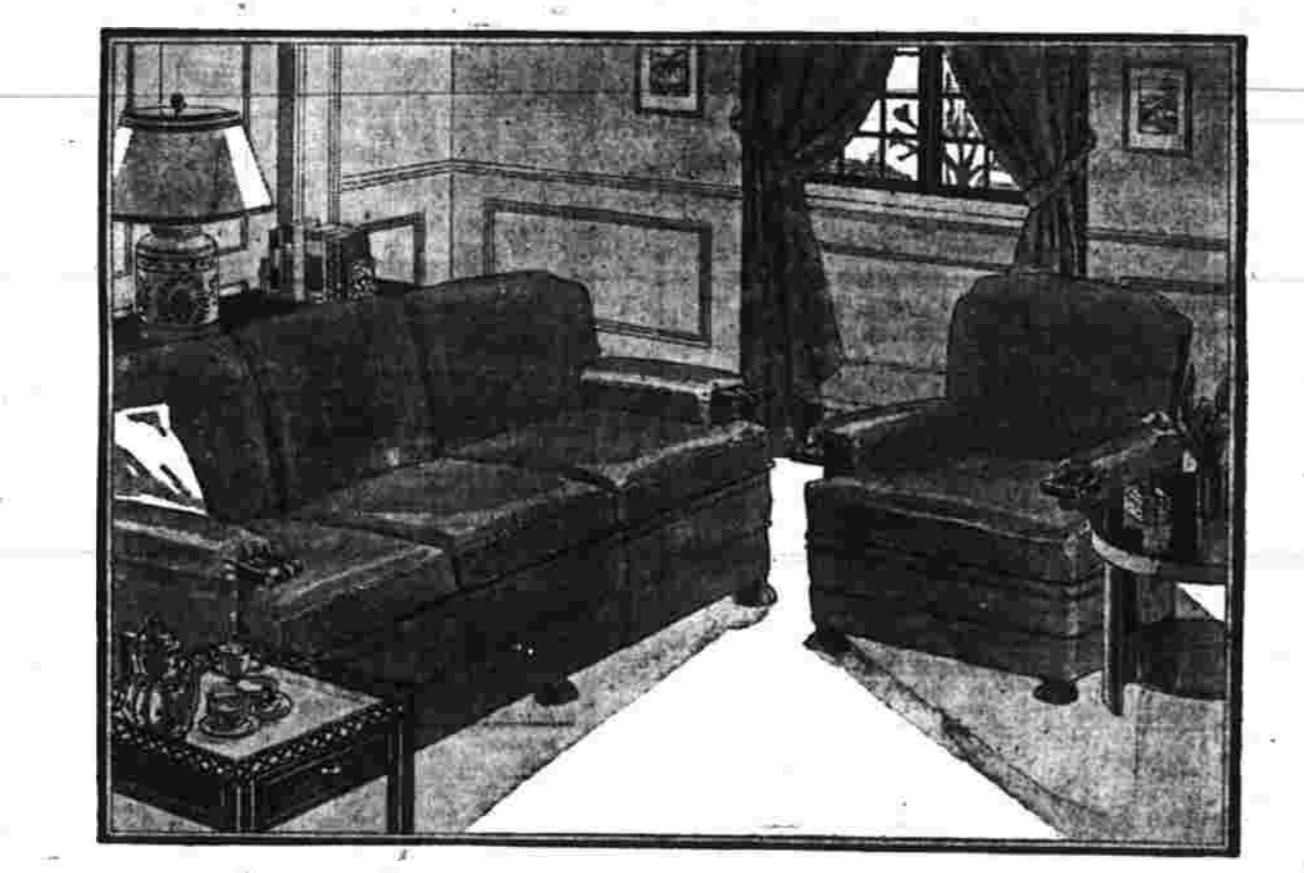
