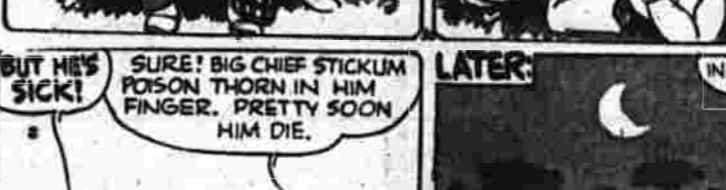

## Stamp News

WITH release of the Virgin Islands stamp Dec. 15, the Postoffice Department is expected to announce the 1938 philatelic program.

Indications are that three commemorative may be issued further marking the 100th anniversary of the Constitution. It is believed that the stamps will be issued in three departments of the government.

The legislative branch would be represented by illustration of the meeting of the first congress under the Constitution; the executive department stamp would portray the inauguration of George Washington; the judicial stamp would depict the creation of the United States Supreme Court in 1789.

Convening of a special session of Congress receives hopes for the printing of black and white illustrations of United States postage stamps. The Senate passed the bill in the House, but the House failed of favorable action.

Interesting new issues: Manchester—Four values, commemorating completion of the capital city. Hallowell—Green—values depicting the city's history. Portland—values depicting the city's history.

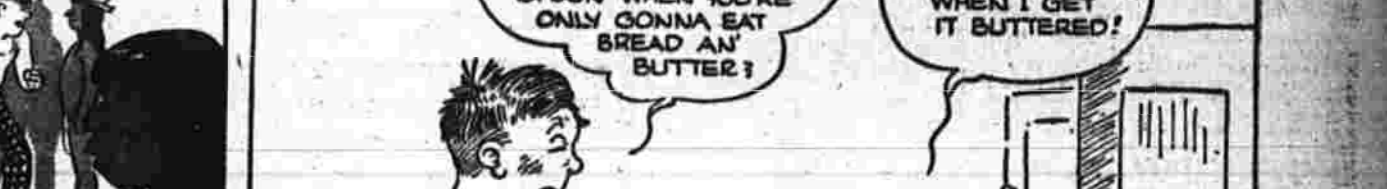
