Local Boys Drive 12,000 Miles For Knowledge And Adventure

Boys Get Many Thrills And One Picks Up Valued Data.

Two months, twelve thousand miles, twenty-four states from coast to coast, and the Gulf of Mexico. This briefly is the start of a most unique journey just completed by two local boys.

Arthur Davis, son of Mrs. E. H. Davis of Center street and Leslie Buckland, son of Mr. and Mrs. F. N. Buckland of Hilltown, have just returned from what might be justly termed an exciting as well as an educational tour.

The "Hurricane" premiere, "The Hurricane" a night in Death Valley, Furnace Creek Ranch, and an afternoon with the world's famous water lily hybridizer, George H. Spring, is to mention but a few of the unique experiences encountered by these young men on their twelve thousand mile tour.

Reasons For Trip

One might inquire, if he were curious, what might be the reason for this extended trip—other than the natural wanderlust of the youth. The reason is a better one than most of us with a hitching post can conceive. Mr. Buckland is an eminent horticulturist specializing in the growing of water lilies. Although he has the best collection of hardy water lilies in New England, and one of the best in the country, he was not satisfied. He was (and still is) anxious to increase his knowledge of water lilies in particular and horticulture in general. This knowledge he has been best to see America first, particularly St. Louis, Mo., and Los Angeles, California, and vicinity, the water lily centers in the United States. This was his belief was the motivating factor.

On October 20th last, the two young men headed their blue-nosed black wagon west. On their way to Idaho, Mr. T. J. stopped for a brief visit with Mrs. Donald Holmes, Mrs. Ruth McKenney, formerly of Manchester, in Idaho. Mr. Buckland spent some time with Dr. E. A. White, head of the Department of Horticulture and Ornamental Horticulture. Mr. Davis and Mr. Buckland stayed with Mr. and Mrs. Gordon Scott Little.

After two days in Idaho, N. Y., the two young men returned to Colorado, where by a piece of rare good fortune they were encountering through the work of Charles Works by friends.

From Corning, Idaho, Mr. Davis was particularly eventful though they did visit a number of water lily gardens near Cleveland, and a former prep school teacher in Hudson, N. Y. Mr. Davis visited the famous two and one-half mile away where the 500 mile open class is held every May in Cleveland, where the largest and best water lilies were spread out before them.

In St. Louis, Mr. Buckland experienced what was for him the greatest thrill of the entire trip. Mr. Davis would probably disagree in favor of Hollywood—and, of course, Mr. George F. Smith, superintendent of the Missouri Botanical Garden was kind enough to spend one entire afternoon showing these young men through all the large W. B. Shaw gardens, which combined with the fact that Mr. Spring is the foremost water lily hybridizer in the world, and his visit to St. Louis a memorable one.

From St. Louis to Denver, Colorado, proved to be a very interesting rather than uninteresting visit, and corn country they stopped briefly at the University of Missouri in Columbia, then proceeded on to Denver, Colorado, where they visited the thrilling spectacle of the snow-capped Rockies in the background. They then drove north some forty miles to Boulder, where the University of Colorado is so beautifully nestled at the very foot hills of the Rockies, and saw the most beautiful colored canyons they visited on their entire trip. From Boulder, back down to Denver and south to Colorado Springs, and then to the Garden of the Gods, where they spent some time taking photographs, knowing that with no photographs could they reproduce the spectacular brilliance of their own color and strange rock formations.

From Colorado Springs to Pueblo to Trinidad, on up over the high Indian Pass, eventually down to Las Vegas, New Mexico, where they spent a night. From here they moved on to Santa Fe, the capital, where Mexican in tone and extremely interesting, then on to Albuquerque, the largest city in New Mexico.

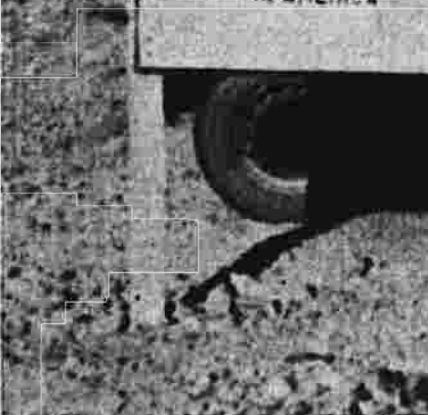
