GRAND JURY PROBE OF STATE PARKWAY WITHIN TWO WEEKS

State Officials Arrange Data To Present in Fairfield County; Gov. Cross Says It Is The Only Thing To Do

Hartford, Jan. 6.—(AP)—State officials labored today to whip into shape data obtained in preliminary inquiries for presentation to a Fairfield County Grand Jury which will be summoned "within two weeks" to investigate the Merritt Parkway project.

Attorney General Charles McLaughlin, who announced late yesterday the decision to convene the Grand Jury, offered his "utmost cooperation" to Governor William W. Cross in the probe of the activities of the Highway Department in connection with the 27-mile scenic highway, now being completed at an estimated cost of \$20,000,000.

"The only thing to do" is the only thing to do, the governor, who ordered official inquiries begun after reports had been published that land was purchased for Parkway right-of-way at prices far above assessed valuations, said of the decision to call a Grand Jury.

McLaughlin's announcement was made after he advised the governor his preliminary investigation of the Merritt Parkway transactions led him to believe "there exists sufficient evidence to warrant a more complete and intensive inquiry of the subject matter."

Rescues Not Unusual To Makulis Brothers
