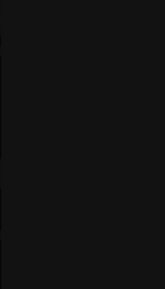

U.S.-ITALY PACT ON TRADE HALTED

State Department Refuses To Recognize King As The Emperor Of Ethiopia.

Washington, Jan. 12 (AP)—Negotiations for a trade treaty between Italy and the United States have been suspended. It was learned today because of Italian insistence that Secretary Hui admit King Victor Emmanuel's right to the title of Emperor of Ethiopia.

State Department trade officials said they were seeking some means of ending the stalemate. Actual negotiations were expected to lapse at least for several months, during which the Italian government would continue to make overtures to the United States.

Secretary Hull continued his international trade program, however, by announcing that hearings will begin Feb. 20 on a commercial agreement with Turkey.

American interests were hopeful of selling machinery to the Turkish government. Items which might be considered include tobacco, grain, meat, rubber, cotton, chrome, iron, steel, and other raw materials.

Germany now handles most of Turkey's foreign trade. In 1935 Germany sold Turkey 45 per cent of its imports and the United States sent only 10 per cent.
