SPIES: Russia 'Tries' Them Why 'Traitors' Confess

Twenty-one men, sitting this week in the prisoners' box of a Moscow court, charged with conspiring and spying to aid fascist powers and destroy the U. S. S. R., all admitted their guilt.

When the trial began last week, one man repudiated his confession—but the next day he confessed again. This week another defendant denied his confession was wholly true. Why? 




