Early Primary Expected To Show Strength Of New Deal In 1938; Pepper Faces 4 Rivals For Senate

Washington, April 25.—(AP)—Florida's primary election contest for the Democratic senatorial nomination may provide the first real test of the Roosevelt administration's popularity at the polls this year. The Florida Democrats will hold a caucus on May 2 to select candidates for the state and two more—in Pennsylvania and Oregon—will follow late in May. News of these, however, now appears likely to furnish such a clear picture of administration strength as that in Florida.

BRITAIN YIELDS 3 NAVAL BASES IN IRISH PACT

London, April 25.—(AP)—Neville Chamberlain and Eamon De Valera, prime ministers of Great Britain and Ireland, today signed an agreement intended to end old animosities between the two countries and settle their trade and defense disputes. Under the defense agreement, it was predicted Britain would relinquish the right to three naval bases—Spike Island in Cork harbor, Bere Islands off County Cork and Lough Swilly in County Donegal—which were fortified and equipped by Ireland.

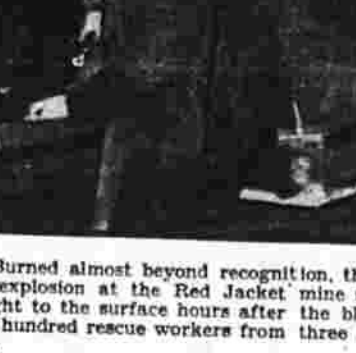

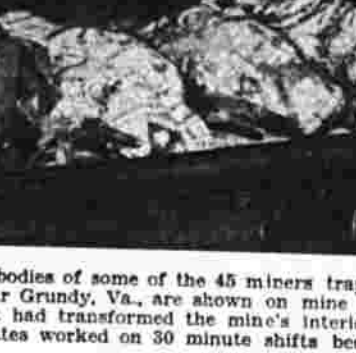

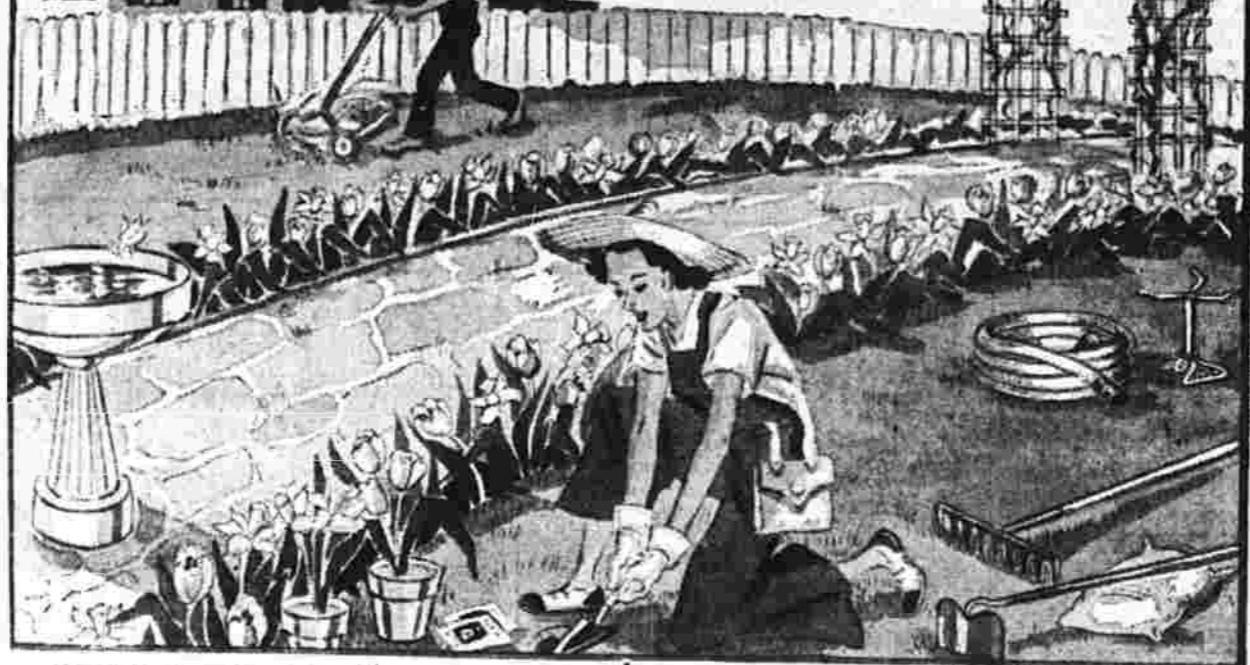
