Atoms Made to Work Without Using Energy

Only when shooting about at random do atoms, according to scientists, demonstrate today before members of the American Physical Society how they make atoms, or particles of atoms, work without using energy. The apparent violation of one of the fundamental laws of physics was accomplished by putting pieces of the liquid helium, the liquid gas used to cool atoms, in a bath of liquid helium. The temperature of the liquid helium was held at 2 degrees Centigrade below zero. At these temperatures, very close to absolute zero, these metals became "superconductors" of electricity. Prof. E. F.
