

LEGION ASKED TO RENEW ATTACK ON CONN. COMMUNISTS

American Director Appeals For Support Of Educational Effort To Combat Subversive Doctrines.

New London, July 28.—(AP)—Reporting to the American Legion's state convention here today that there has been no slackening of Communist activity in Connecticut during the past year, John R. Reitemeyer, American director of the Connecticut department, appealed for renewed vigor in the Legion's educational effort and in the emphasis on the study of the constitution of the United States, stating that "we still believe that the most effective way to combat subversive doctrines is through education."

PROPOSED LAW WOULD GRANT LOCAL RULING
