### EXPLORING NEW FIELDS FOR SOCIAL INSURANCE

#### Protection For Dependents And Disability Payments To Be Considered By Advisory Council This Week.

Editor's note: When the Advisory Council on Social Security meets here Friday it may consider a number of proposals calling for broad expansion of the Social Security Act. Some of these proposals which federal experts say are most likely to be given full attention are discussed in a series of articles appearing in this column. The following is the second of these articles.

Washington, Oct. 18.—(AP)—Two completely new fields of social insurance are being explored by advocates of expansion of the Social Security program. One is that of protection for the dependents of persons covered by old age pensions—their wives and dependent children. The other is that of disability insurance for workers kept from earning a living by illness or accident. Here, too, the question of care for dependents has been raised.

#### Statistics Indicate that when old age insurance payments start, the average retired wage earner may receive about \$30 to \$40 a month. If provision were made for wife and also, the family's combined income would be \$45 to \$60.

#### Advocates of this plan claim it would have the advantage of holding the family together as a unit, give children a normal home atmosphere in which to grow up and most directly a responsibility which the public already is meeting in part, since most children made dependent by a father's death must be cared for out of public funds.



