CONTROL SUGGESTIONS FOR CUCUMBER PESTS

Control suggestions for two-person afflictions of members of the group family are very significant.

On the very day when striped cucumber beetles appear on seedlings of squash, melon, cucumber and related vegetables or ornamental plants, use Rotonec dust; look for and get rid of these same pests in order to protect the plants from bacterial wilt, says circular 121 of the Agricultural Experiment Station.

When fall grown the larvae plant a length of one-third inch and have a brownish head and anal plate. At this stage, resting in the soil as white pupae for about a week before they transform into beetles.

Then they emerge from the ground with their voracious appetites and hold a fatal feast before retiring for the winter.

The beetle can do enough injury to the vine accord, as it did in many places in Connecticut last summer.

In seasons that favor wilt, however, this disease may add considerably to the havoc in the garden. It is a good idea, therefore, to recognize and to know how to control the striped cucumber beetle.

This pest is now hibernating under trash or underground in the garden. It is about one-quarter of an inch long and has a black head and yellow wing covers marked by three longitudinal black stripes.

Flowers of these small but striking beetles appear on the plants soon after the seeds germinate, and feed usually on the underside, but also on both surfaces, of the leaves.

Adult females begin egg-laying about the middle of August, depositing the eggs on the ground or in crevices in the soil. After a period of approximately a month, the young are hatched and begin to feed on the plants.

BRITISH PREPARE TO CONTROL AIR

Nation Aiming At World Supremacy In Aviation, Balloon Announces.

London, Dec. 2.—(AP)—Great Britain is preparing for a giant effort to give British commerce supremacy in the air comparable to its virtual monopoly of ocean routes.

Recent announcement of plans to merge Britain's two largest commercial air lines was followed up last night with a declaration by Capt. H. H. Buller, undersecretary of air, that Air Minister Sir Kingsley Wood was aiming at "world supremacy for British aviation."

Britain already is operating the world's longest commercial air route—13,000 miles from Southampton to Australia.

Some time ago she announced plans for transatlantic service and later disclosed plans for a globe-circling line by extending the Australian route through New Zealand and back to England.

These plans have been delayed by inadequate facilities for the production of big planes in Britain and a "lack of necessary funds."

To Revamp Organization. Meanwhile, the British chamber of commerce has urged Sir Kingsley to start a proposed British air line to South America, and the government has set Sir John Reith in charge of the government-subsidized Imperial Airways to revamp the entire organization as he did for the British Broadcasting Company.

The air minister told the House of Commons last month that Imperial Airways and British Airways would be merged to form the "most satisfactory instrument for the development of British overseas civil aviation."

But Sir John, who says he knows little or nothing about flying, has appointed a diving pilot, W. L. Runciman, to share control of the new merger with him.

Runciman, who is actively participating in the affairs of both companies.

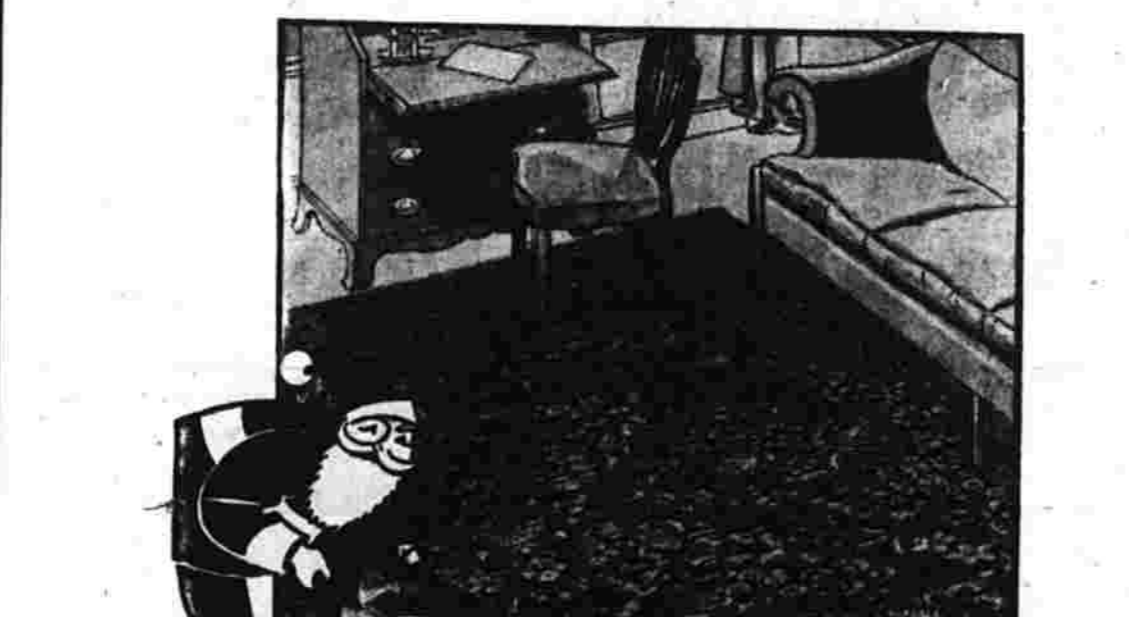
