DEPUTIES APPROVE DALADIER REQUEST TO SPEED PASSAGE

Emergency Measures Provide Appropriation Bills Be Debated By Ministries Instead Of By Details.

Paris, Dec. 13.—(AP)—The Chamber of Deputies today approved Premier Daladier's request for emergency measures to speed passage of the ordinary and extraordinary budgets for 1939.

The measures providing that the appropriation bills be debated by ministries instead of by more detailed chapter divisions, were approved by a show of hands.

Even the Socialists backed the government on the vote, which was purely technical and carried no indication of possible future support of opposition to the 1939 allocations.

Accepts Chamberlain's Statement At The Foreign Office it was said France "accepted" Prime Minister Chamberlain's statement in Parliament yesterday that no pact or treaty would be signed until the French aid in her colonial demands.

Writing in L'Ordre, Fernand said Chamberlain could only recognize that the mutual assistance obligations which unite France and Britain are valid only against Germany.

"It remains nevertheless, that he was certainly wrong to explain it as an economic and not a political pact."

PREMIER WONT ASK COMMONS FOR APPROVAL

Before Opening Any Negotiations With Germany For Return Of Former Colonies Reich Is Seeking

London, Dec. 13.—(AP)—Prime Minister Chamberlain declined today to give the specific assurance that he would get the approval of the House of Commons before opening any negotiations with Germany over the return of former German colonies.

Asked by Duncan Sandys, Conservative, for such assurance Chamberlain replied: "No, I do not think I can undertake it."

The prime minister then referred to a previous government pledge made by Malcolm MacDonald, secretary for colonies and dominions that any colonial agreement would be submitted to Parliament for ratification.

MacDonald also told the House of Commons last week that the colonies were not a matter of practical politics now and was not being considered as a matter of principle.

Chamberlain said yesterday Germany had made no formal demand for the return of former colonies. He said the British government would be based on friendship and the restoration of internationalism must determine her future course.

The premier appealed to Germany, however, to understand "the psychological effects of the loss of territory which we have to overcome."

RACE, RELIGIOUS STAND SOUGHT IN WATERBURY

Questions Designed To Ascertain Prejudices Among Voters Asked; 'Klan' Mentioned By Defense.

Waterbury, Dec. 13.—(AP)—Questions designed to ascertain whether any religious or racial prejudices exist among the voters marked the opening session today of the third week of Waterbury's election trial.
