## CREW OF BOMBED BRITISH STEAMER AFLOAT IN BOATS

### Mazagon, Carrying General Cargo to Barcelona, Had Observer Of Nonintervention Committee Aboard.

**BULLETIN:**  
Hondas, France (AP) — A piercing of government lines at the bridgehead of Balaguer reported late today by insurgent dispatches from the Catalan front. This pier was reported in a vital zone on the river Segre some 15 miles north of Lerida, in the center of the seven-day-old insurgent drive directed toward Barcelona and the sea.

London, Dec. 29 (AP)—Lloyd agent at Gibraltar reported today that an SOS had been received from the 4,200-ton British steamer Mariagon, which read:  
"Bomb. Crew took to boats." The steamer's message gave its position as 38.12 north latitude, 1.7 east longitude, between Castellon on Spain's eastern coast, and the Balearic Islands. Palma, Mallorca, largest of the Balearics, is a Spanish island in the sea.

A message picked up by the Mazagon radio station said the French steamer had been hit by a German plane and was only five miles from the position given.

**Crews of 20**  
The Mariagon formerly was of Greek registry, named at one time Greystone and later Edgemoor. She carries a crew of 20.

The freighter left Oran, Algeria Saturday, and her owners, Neil and Fandell of London, said she was carrying a general cargo to the Nonintervention Committee aboard.

The crew in which she was reported to be on the route of London, consisted of 20 men, including a general cargo of government supplies on the coast of government cities on the Spanish coast.

British government spokesmen told the House of Commons recently there had been 120 attacks on British merchant ships since the outbreak of the Spanish war. About 20 of these attacks, however, were on ships within government Spain's territorial waters where the British government has refused to give protection.

The Mariagon apparently was bombed on the high seas where such an attack is deemed "piracy" by the British government.

## Debutante Develops Severe Case of Grip

Washington, Dec. 29 (AP)—Senator Barkley of Kentucky, the majority leader, said today that if non-partisan county boards were named to investigate complaints of disgruntled relief applicants he would be in favor of having WPA select the boards.
