Construction got underway during the last week of the old year on three federal aid (p. W. A.) bridge projects in the northeastern part of the state. It is announced by the chief engineer, Major H. F. Porter, of the Connecticut State College of Civil Engineering, that the project is well advanced.

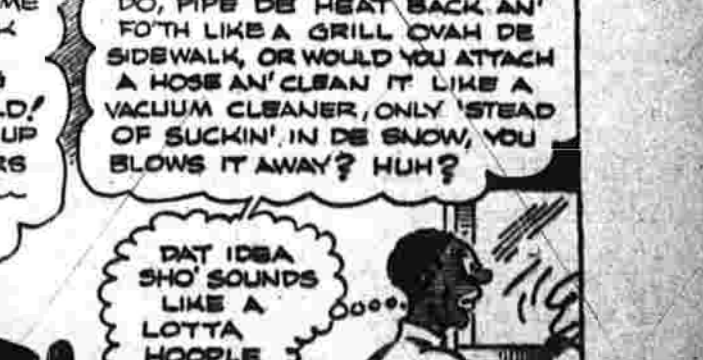
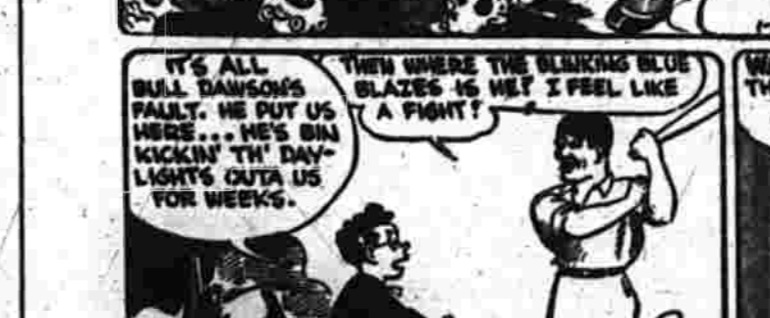
