GERMANY and Japan signed an agreement Nov. 25, 1936, to cooperate in "defense measures" against international communism and invited all other nations—except Russia, of course—to join up. Italy enrolled a year later. This week the fascist axis picked up two more recruits: Hungary and Japan's north China province, Manchoukuo.

Hungary's affiliation, a semi-official Nazi newspaper predicted, will exert a powerful force of attraction upon other similarly minded states. Czechoslovakia, for instance, or Poland, whose foreign minister will confer next week with the Nazi foreign minister, or Rumania, whose farmers need the German market? Or the Turks, who got a big commercial credit from the Nazis this week?

Amid such speculation, a war weary world watched axis adherents in action on two fronts.

In the West Italian soldiers issued an official announcement in an official announcement issued in Rome, with the first Spanish insurgents to enter the country. 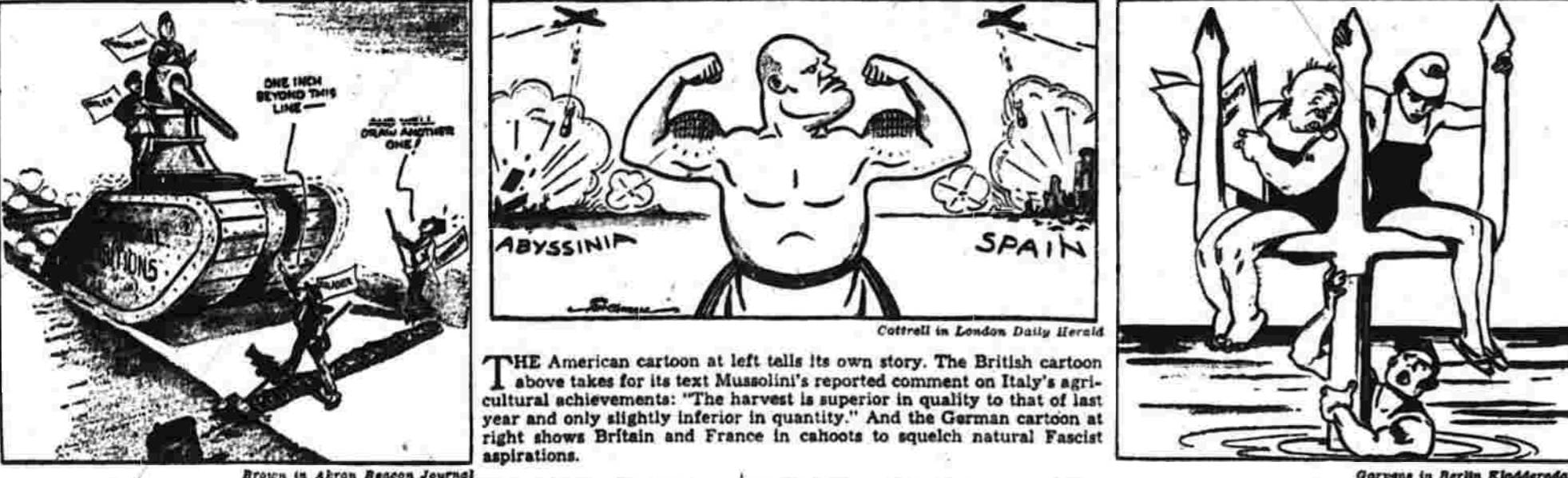
