New Extraction Process

This is based on findings at Arizona that black, ugly particles of carbon love gold, instead of hating it as once thought. In scientific words, the carbon particles absorb the yellow metal, that is stick to it like glue, instead of "precipitating," or throwing it down.

Chapman found the affinity of carbon for gold is so great that it will "stick" the yellow metal while the latter is being liberated from ores by cyanide. The result is cheaper techniques which will recover as much gold, and sometimes more than by present cyanide methods.
