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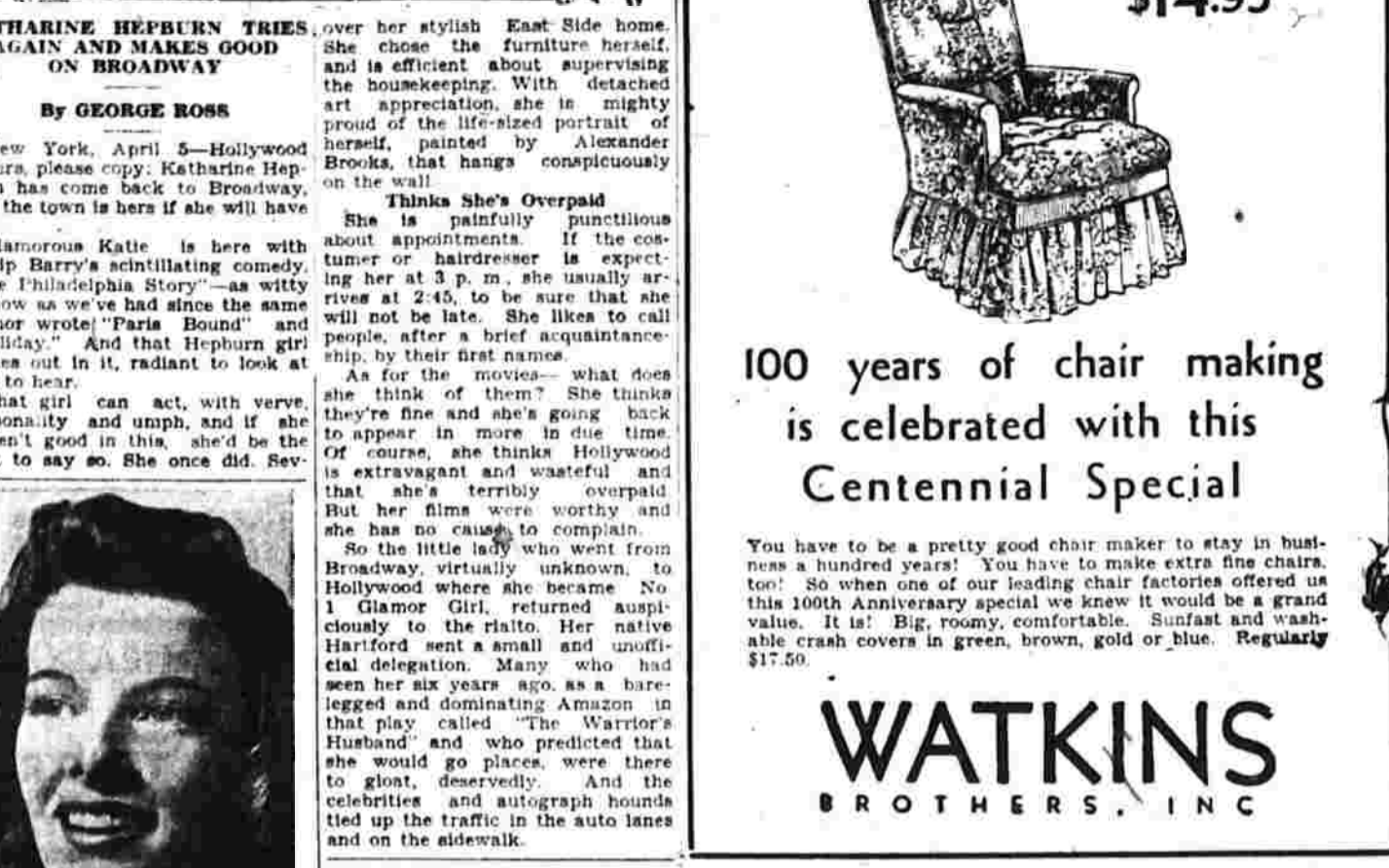
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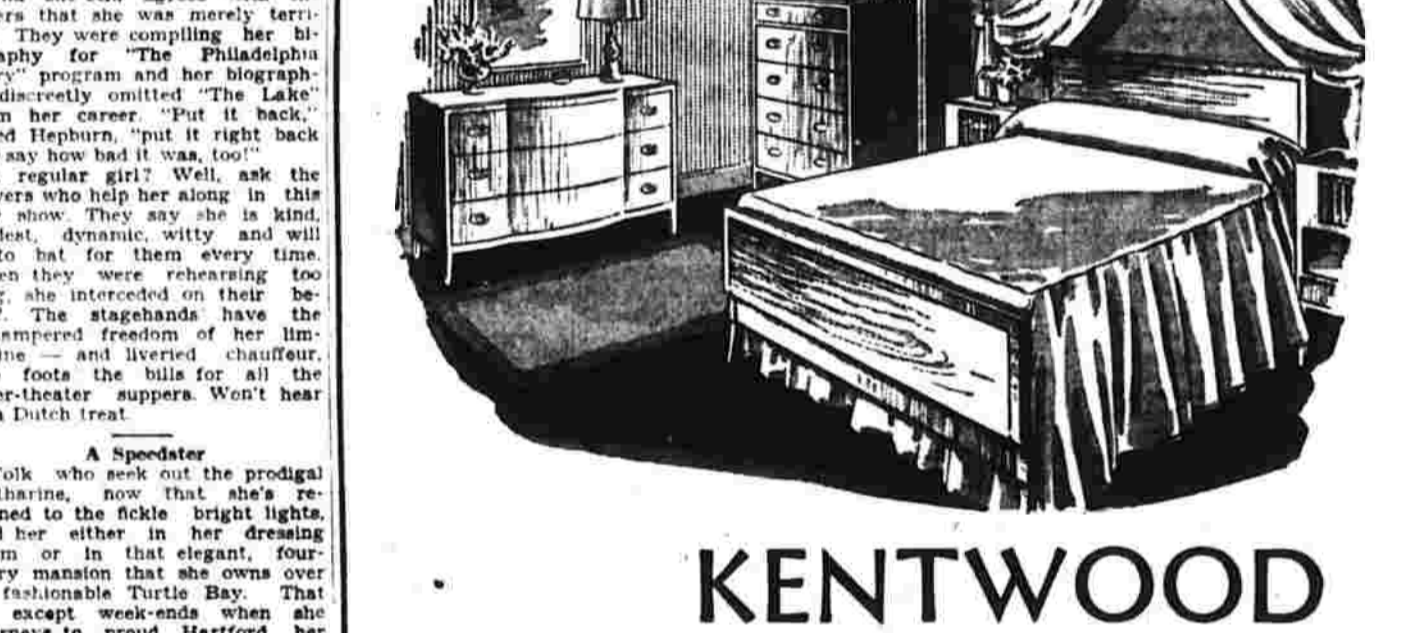

KEENEY FAMILY LINKED WITH HISTORY OF TOWN

Eleven Members Among Proprietors of Site Later to Become Manchester; Founded N. Y. Settlement

One of the oldest families in Manchester, in point of town settlement is the Keeney family contemporary with the Bushwells, Williams, Spencers, Olcotts, Tuckers and other early settlers. The Keeney family was probably the first to build a cabin on one of the hills in the southeast part of the town now known as Bush Hill.

These five men were Simon Keeney, Jr., Benjamin Brown, Jr., Gordon Woodruff, Samuel Fox and Jonathan Webster. Webster and married the sister of Simon Keeney, Jr. and married Dorinda Webster. Samuel Fox had married Mary Webster, Gordon Woodruff had married Anna Webster, and Simon Keeney, Jr. had married Dorinda Webster.

Before launching their enterprise in the New York wilderness each had sold his land in Connecticut and the date they had sold it show the same date—April 1, 1785.

The five men went by way of Adirondack following the Hudson river to Ulster and probably by way of the Hudson river to the site of the settlement. The five men who reached Manhattan they directed to the southwest.

Temporarily twenty persons occupied the one big cabin previous to being built by the five men. The cabin was until after the house had been built. The house had been built in the previous summer, dug from under the snow.

Soop these settlers were forced by others from East Hartford and Eastbury in Connecticut including Thomas Keeney and Nathaniel McKee, Jr. and became a strong body devoted to religion and industry in a remarkable degree. Their names are to be found among the founders of the First Baptist church and Society of Faith N. Y.

Keeney Valley which was given the name of the Manchester family was wholly in Orange County, N. Y. was part of the town of Pompey and was then an unincorporated territory. In time Pompey was set apart from Dutchess and the first town meeting was held April 1, 1788.
