History of United States In Painting Fair Exhibit

New York, April 22.—(AP)—The Metropolitan Museum of Art's gift to the New York World Fair will be opened Monday afternoon with a preview for invited guests at the museum. It turns out to be a history of the United States in painting.

One of the largest shows assembled in recent years, it also is one of the most amusing. There are 200 paintings on the walls of nine galleries. A large group of Museum officials has been at work for a year assembling the canvases from every corner of America.

Chosen for history content, the paintings illustrate great persons and events from 1616 to the World War. They were chosen for their historical content, the museum officials say.

"For obvious reasons," remarks Museum Director William J. Goetz, "we sought to find no studies in black and blue, no touchings and blumes on a plain background. The exhibition offers the substantial and best of American art."

Aviation News From State Dept.

Business men like airplanes. A number of Connecticut businessmen are planning to buy one this spring in order to transport customers, salesmen and executives to and from New York. Airplane bridge the gap between New England and the United States, they say.

The airports in Connecticut last year received over 8000 persons by air. 5700 of these came from other states, and 2600 went into the city or neighboring communities, for reasons of business or pleasure.

Every airport in Connecticut is certified for flying. Even the "back lot" that is used for week-end passenger hops must be approved before commercial flying is permitted.

It costs an average of about \$9.00 to lease a plane for an hour. You can hold it for about 8 hours, an \$75 should get you up into the air. \$10 more should be added for your first physical examination.

Physical examinations for flying are taken at any one of four bases in Connecticut. Hartford, New Haven, Bridgeport and New London. The "back lot" "whirling chair" and other such gadgets are past history.

Physical examinations for flying were given to 67 people in Connecticut last year. Of these, 170 were originally applicants, and only 47 of the 67 were rejected.

Last year, Connecticut's aircraft inspectors inspected 74 of these ships were temporarily rejected until necessary repairs were made.



TELLS OF FIGHTING FROST BY USING ICE

Atlanta, April 22.—(AP)—An experiment in fighting frost with ice in Florida was described by the American Meteorological Society in a paper by Ray T. Sherman of the Lakeland, Fla. Weather Bureau today.

The studies were conducted by projecting the tender asparagus plants from frost injury with a sprinkler irrigation system. Plants, by being continuously sprayed with water, were successfully brought through 48 hour periods where the temperatures dropped as low as 25 degrees emerging apparently unharmed from the coating of ice that formed without frost.


