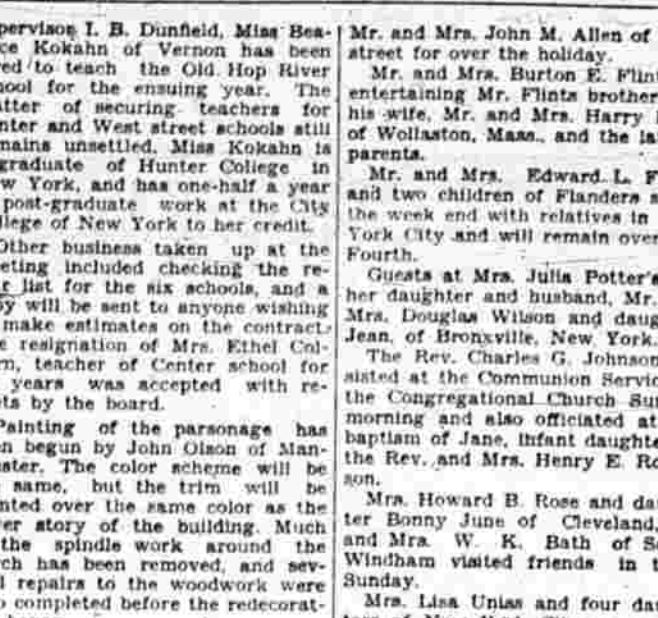

To Ask Ban on Political Activities of Jobholders

Washington, July 5.—Representative M. J. Connelley today introduced a bill to ban such Federal office holders as district attorneys and tax collectors from an active part in political management or in political campaigns.

That language, stricken from the Hatch bill, "prohibits political activities" by the House Judiciary Committee, will be offered as an amendment, M. J. Connelley said, either by himself or some colleague on the committee.

The bill is expected to come before the House next week or shortly after.

Approval of M. J. Connelley's bill is expected to take effect of relief and prevent coercion of Federal job holders by their political employers by their superiors, expressed approval of M. J. Connelley's bill.

"I believe," M. J. Connelley added, "that a majority in the House favors carrying out the objective of the original bill, which was to prevent Federal employees from being coerced by their superiors in their political activities."

President Roosevelt said a few weeks ago that everyone favored the bill's objective, but it was badly drawn. He added that the House Judiciary Committee was attempting to redraft it.

Subsequently, the committee eliminated one sentence preventing Federal office holders from taking an "active part" in political campaigns.

House Office Administration said in a report that the committee had proposed to ban Federal employees from being coerced by their superiors in their political activities.
