Still On Her Own

If Poland delivers to the Danzig senate within the next day or two a warning to cease military preparations, as it is currently believed she will, the effect of such a communication can scarcely be regarded as anything less than that of an ultimatum.

Also the taking of such a step would seem to indicate that Poland either alone or with backing of which she is wholly assured, proposes to end the present inoperative truce by precipitating a show down, perhaps believing that Hitler, in the last analysis, will not fight or else that if he does fight he would be quickly beaten and the end of the intolerable Nazi threat would be achieved.

It is to be strongly suspected that if there should transpire any such reversal of recent history as an ultimatum going to Hitler instead of coming from him, it will be from some quarter that does not altogether depend on the support of Great Britain.

Despite the great acclaim extended to the Lord Halifax speech of last week and Hore-Belisha's thunder about the vast military might of the Franco-British alliance of two or two ago, opposition members of Parliament have been totally unable to get Mr. Chamberlain or any other responsible member of the British government to declare unequivocally that Britain would resort to arms to prevent any change in the status of the Danzig Corridor or of the Free City. So far as the situation of any definite pledge given to Poland is concerned, Poland is on her own in this Danzig affair.

Perhaps Poland has her own private agreement with Russia, which apart from the Franco-British-Soviet alliance has been the only subject of jockeying now for 1837 weeks. Whether or not, it also would be practical ultimatum.

Denying this week it is more reasonable to assume that she is doing it without any hope of help from Great Britain than that she is depending on such aid.

Chain Stores and Fido

According to a statement issued by the chain store interests here, the rejection by Connecticut's Legislature of a chain store tax bill puts this state in line with five other state legislatures which have also refused to pass such measures this year.

WPA Strikes

If there is a single point at which the new Federal Relief Bill, now in effect, attached to the status of society, it would appear to be the one where it did away with the recognition of craft wage scales in determining the composition of the WPA workers.

Through no state has repealed a tax bill of this kind this year, none has passed one and the chain store people appear to be rather unimpatiently confident that the move to seek the chain stores, which for a number of years had been fighting recently appeared to be advancing with much rapidity, is on the verge of peaking out.
