The Sewer Tangle

It may be just a little bit late in the day to mention it, but perhaps there are some readers of this newspaper who will remember the position taken by The Herald at the time of the purchase of the Manchester Water Company's properties and those of the South Manchester Sanitary District, both owned by Chesney Brothers, by the town of Manchester.

The Herald maintained then that, while the purchase of the water supply would be good business for the town, it was not a sewer system it would be buying a kettle of fish sufficiently far gone so that it might turn out to be a highly undesirable, and possibly a malodorous, possession.

The opinion handed down by Judge Raymond R. Bowers of the Superior Court in the case of the Manchester Town Council, in the last month brought by the town against David H. Nelson to collect a charge for sewer disposal, while it is technically favorable to the town, appears to accentuate the cloudiness of the town's owner position with relation to the South East sewer system.

We maintained six years ago that it was extremely questionable whether, in the sewer system at the end of the town, Chesney Brothers had anything whatever to sell. As a voluntary service to the community they had laid a great many sewer under public streets and treated them to community use. If they held any subsequent claim to ownership over these utilities it was a nuisance one which, after a number of years, they made no attempt to exercise. It was not until more than thirty years after the laying of many of these sewers that they set up a charge for their use, under cover of a special act of the Legislature concerning such matters.

It is to be hoped that if the sewerage commission does undertake to get at the bottom of the matter in the case of the South East sewer, it will not overlook the fact that the sewerage disposal of patients may be indirectly responsible for the sewerage disposal where the responsibility is not exactly obvious.
