New Warning to Britons

London, Aug. 18.—A new warning to all Britons to leave Szechwan province was given today in letters mailed to British consuls and consulates by the "China Patriotic Youth Association."

The letters named Great Britain as the aggressor in the Szechwan province and urged that Britons leave quickly they might lose their lives or property. It said that the Japanese are now in possession of the Szechwan province and that they will be forced to leave the Szechwan province if they do not.
