New Ocean Air Line for 1940

American Export Line Plans Fleet of 18 Sea-Going Vessels in 1940.

New York, Aug. 29.—When 42,500 pounds of flying boat lifted its sleek, dripping belly from the waters of Long Island Sound last month and roared out over the ocean on the first scheduled passenger flight ever to be made across the Atlantic, aviation history was again made.

Currently, four foreign airlines contemplate a similar trans-Atlantic service while a fifth, Great Britain's Imperial Airways, is now operating an across-the-Atlantic mail service once a week, and France's Air France, Germany's Luft Hansa, Holland's K. L. M., and Italy's Ala Littoria have many kinks to iron out before they can go into operation.

Only Germany is ready, but she still faces the stumbling block of being unable to obtain a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity from the U. S. Civil Aeronautics Authority which would permit her to fly and carry mail to the United States.

Another American company is about ready to enter the trans-Atlantic competition—American Export Line. This company has mapped a ten-year expansion program of regular non-stop flights between New York, France, Italy and the eastern Mediterranean.

Ships Will Be Weather Stations
A major item in American Ex-

port's flight plans is the fleet of 18 sea-going vessels they will have one of their ships always somewhere between the U. S. and Bermuda; a second between Bermuda and the Azores; a third between the Azores and Portugal.

In these positions, and equipped with special weather observation equipment capable of taking observations to 30,000 feet, these vessels would be mobile weather stations.

American Export Air Lines has substantiated its plans not only with a survey that tells them that by the tenth year after the service starts 100,000 passengers will be booking plane passages each year, but by outlay during the past three years of solid cash for salaries and the purchase of a Consolidated flying boat for survey flights.

Only Two Foreign Lines Permitted
It has been estimated by the Civil Aeronautics Authority that there is only sufficient mail to warrant authorization of four round trip flights each week to Europe by U. S. airlines. So until mail grows to a point where more than two American airlines can operate with mail subsidies, no more than two competitive foreign airlines will be permitted to operate passenger planes to the United States.

Pan American and Imperial Airways are now operating under the given permit. France will probably be the second foreign nation to be given permission rather than Germany or Italy because the two ax-powers are geographically of secondary importance in the landing of Europe-bound American ships.

And it is the hope of American Export that they will be the second U. S. airline to gain a permit. If they do—and they'll be sent their case next month in Washington for the all-important certificate which stipulates the route, number of flights and amount of compensation to be received for air mail—American Export will be carrying passengers in 1940.
