### Creed on 'Americanism' Posted in High School

**Biishop Freeman's Definition Is Sent to Faculty Members Today by Principal Bailey.**

The following notice has been sent to all members of the faculty of Manchester High School:

"Americanism is complete and unqualified loyalty to the ideals of government set forth in the Bill of Rights, the Declaration of Independence and the Constitution of the United States. It is respect for and ready obedience to duly constituted authority and the laws of the land. It is freedom without license, religion without bigotry, respect for all nationalities without antagonizing aliens, Christian charity without bias, respect for the rights of all races, and a desire to defend that for which it stands against every alien and subversive influence from without or within. This is Americanism."

This definition was written by Bishop James E. Freeman, major in the Officers Reserve Corps of the United States Army, and appeared in the American Monthly, published by the Rev. M. Bailey believes it to be the best definition of Americanism published in the school history.

Teachers have been instructed to read this definition to their classes and to discuss the various points of view on the subject with their pupils. It is the duty of every citizen to know the meaning of Americanism and to live up to its principles.

It takes a lot of equipment to sink a submarine. Mines, strung at several depths, can get them at the mouth of a harbor, but at sea it's tricky business.
