Famous Americans Two of Most Unnoticed Figures in Washington

Washington (AP)—Two of the most famous Americans in Washington today are men whose names you have not heard for 21 years. They are Gen. John J. Pershing and Charles Lindbergh.

Pershing, 78-year-old commander of America's expeditionary forces during the World War, is in Walter Reed hospital—not ill, but resting and receiving medical attention.

Lindbergh, whose solo flight to France won him world acclaim, is in the War Department.

Both men were government officials 100,000 other Washingtonians are working for the government and have offices here. Lindbergh has been surveying various phases of aircraft production.

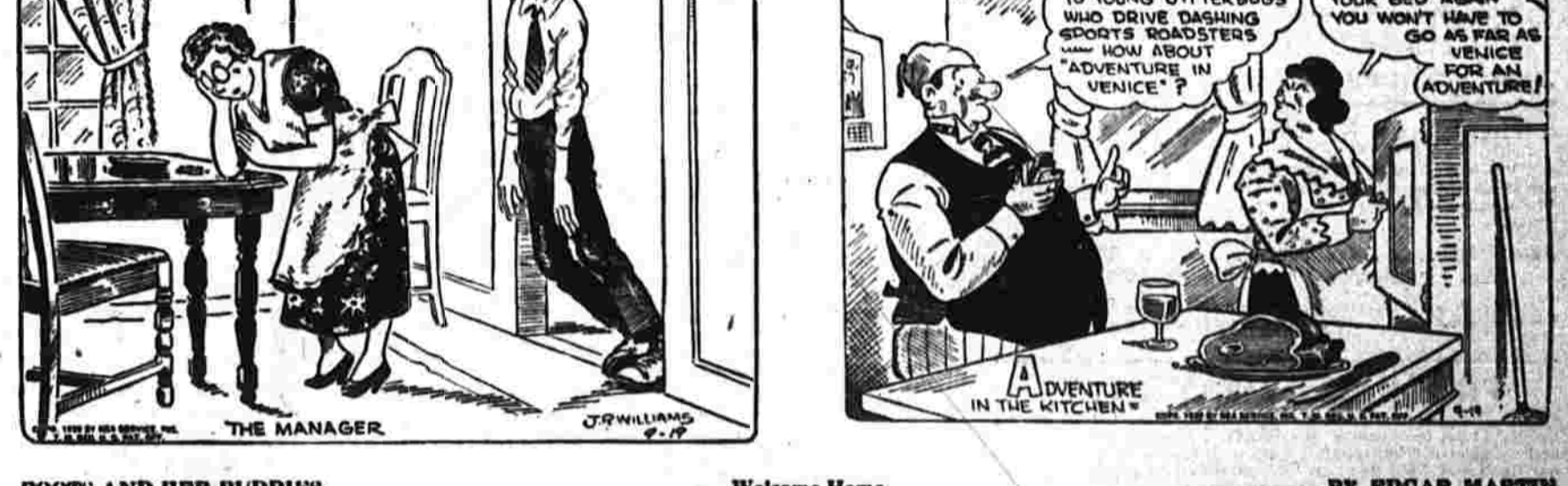
