Police Radio System To Be Installed Here

Police Board Signs Contract for Installation; To Cost \$83,475; How The System Works.

The Board of Police Commissioners last night signed a contract with the Radio Corporation of America, through its New England representative, Irving Strauss, for the installation of a two-way radio system at a cost of \$83,475.

The contract was signed at 11:45 after the commission had again questioned Mr. Strauss concerning the operation of the system. He was called into the board room to answer the questions of the commission members. Strauss stated that the radio system will be installed at central headquarters and at 15 police stations. The system will be able to transmit for a distance of 15 miles.

Details of System.

The contract calls for installation of the main set in the police station. There will be a loud speaker in the office of the officer on duty which will be always open so that his answers will be made by the use of a telephone set. In case of an emergency, a call coming to the police station will be transmitted to a switch at the desk and a switch at the loud speaker is cut out.

The change necessary in the main set and generator is being made in the upper part of the station where it cannot be reached by vandals. The antenna will be erected on the roof, it will be similar to a radio antenna and will be two inches across and each seven feet will be attached to a smaller pole. This will extend 50 feet above the roof and to this height Queen road will be 12 feet higher, making a total height of 62 feet. There will be two masts, one for the main set and the other for the building on the street.

Three New Cars

All three cars that will be equipped with the new radio apparatus will be new. The other two cars that will be used for them, but will not be put into use until they are equipped for radio.

The head of the Communist party in this country appeared in court yesterday on his release from a Federal detainer cell after bonds of \$7,500 had been posted by Mrs. Hester G. Huntington.

Mrs. Huntington, a society woman and sister-in-law of Robert Minor, a Communist leader, said she furnished bail "as a matter of principle."

Referring to a subpoena, she testified later in the day before Judge E. J. Connelley that she had signed the release of Browder in his injury into the hands of a "refugee" and "American traveling credentials" to Communist agents and to the "Marlin Dixie" and "Immortal" war mongers for his prosecution.

Declaring the action against Browder to be "an obvious and direct product of the manufactured war hysteria," she stated that the "legal absurdity of the proceedings is revealed by the fact that even the reactionary Hoover regime, which had this alleged refugee in its custody, did not extradite him, decided there were no grounds for prosecution.

"It is a well known fact that it appears my so-called crime, committed in many years, is a custom of the highest American social justice," she stated, "and that my restoration in high society, if it should be established as a crime."
