Missionary from India Talks on Work There

Speaks at the Nazarene Church, Tells of Experiences in Jungles During Six Years Stay.

Mrs. Margaret Stewart, R. N., principal of the Chikita mission school for girls in Berne, India, spoke for aid for the Nazarene Foreign Mission yesterday at the morning service and Sunday school. Mrs. Stewart returned from the mission recently after six years work. She gave an interesting description of the little known difficulties encountered by the missionary workers competing against the climate and Hindu practices.

Mrs. Stewart was born in Lowell, Mass., graduated from the Nazarene College, Nazareth, Pa., with the degree of A. B. She later obtained a British certificate of proficiency from Boston Hospital, Glasgow, Scotland before coming to India.

Shortly after reaching the mission field in 1923 the area served by the denomination was divided into an adjoining part by the Nazarene church, which was then under the leadership of the Nazarene church.

As a medical missionary, Mrs. Stewart used to go to the sick and treated wounds and diseases of the people. In many of the villages missionaries have never set foot in before.

Mrs. Stewart described her work in the girls school in Chikita, India. She gave an interesting account of the rescue of an Indian beggar from his home village, her subsequent transformation and conversion to Christianity, a clean, hopeful life, and her contact with the missionary project.
