Navy May Ask for Funds For Anti-Submarine Nets
Washington, Nov. 24.—Congressional sources today said that the Navy may ask Congress for \$50 million to buy anti-submarine nets for the Atlantic and Pacific oceans.
The Navy has developed a new type of anti-submarine net that is said to be more effective than the old type. The new net is made of three-inch steel bars in a mesh small enough to stop torpedoes as well as submarines.
