First Lady Again Attends Hearing Of Dies Probers

Goes to Hear Testimony By Leaders of American Youth Organizations; President Refuses to Tell Stand On Probe Continuation

Washington, Dec. 1.—(AP)—Mrs. Franklin D. Roosevelt today made her third visit to the Dies Committee to hear testimony by leaders of American youth organizations.

Meanwhile, at a press conference President Roosevelt refused to say whether he favored continuation of the committee's investigation of American activities. It is scheduled to expire Jan. 3, but Chairman Dies has asked the President to extend the House for a year's extension and also has challenged the administration either to support the committee or declare its opposition.

Mr. Roosevelt said continuation of the committee was a matter for Congress to consider. Congress has the right to set up a special committee if it wants to, he added.

No Emergency Facing Nation's Electric Power

Washington, Dec. 1.—(AP)—President Roosevelt said today that there was no immediate emergency in the electric power supply for the nation and that private power companies, in planning expansion of their plants, need not be concerned over the electric power supply for the nation.

Invasion Seen As Big Shock By Roosevelt

Chief Executive Says All Peace Loving Peoples Will Condemn New Resort to Military Force.

Washington, Dec. 1.—(AP)—President Roosevelt declared today that Russia's invasion of Finland was a "profound shock" to the United States and jeopardized "the rights of mankind to self-government."

In a formal statement read to a press conference, the chief executive said all peace-loving peoples would "unanimously condemn this new resort to military force as the prerogative of international differences."

The president's statement in full follows:

"The news of the Soviet Naval invasion of Finland is a profound shock to the government and people of the United States. Despite efforts made to solve the problem by peaceful methods to which no reasonable objection could be offered, no power has chosen to respect the rights of Finland to self-determination."

"Tragic to see the policy of peace spreading to realize that wanton disregard for law is still on the march."

"All peace-loving peoples in these nations that are still hoping for the continuation of relations throughout the world on the basis of mutual respect and honor, condemn this new resort to military force as the prerogative of international differences."

Nazis Claim 194 Ships Sunk by Mines, Subs

Sinking of 162 Vessels Confirmed by German Sources; Total Losses Believed Much Larger

Berlin, Dec. 1.—(AP)—DNR official German news agency reported today that from the beginning of the war to Nov. 28, 1939, a total of 194 ships had been sunk by German submarines and mines.

The DNR said the sinking of 162 ships—52 of them neutral—totaling 629,422 tons was confirmed by German reports.

Non-German sources, the agency said, disclosed an additional 23 ships of 96,079 tons, half of them neutral, representing 39,321 tons.

Japan Silent On Invasion

Attitude Seen Indicative of Aims at Russian Rapprochement

Tokyo, Dec. 1.—(AP)—Japan, pressing toward friendly relations with Soviet Russia, kept offensively silent today on the invasion of Poland by Germany.

Moscow, Dec. 1.—(AP)—The spokesman of the Finnish legation said today that the Soviet Russian government had removed the legation's telephones and that the staff was still unable to obtain passports for its departure.

Officials of the legation were unable to get in touch with the Soviet government and it was thought possible in some quarters that permission might be refused until the staff of the Soviet consulate in Helsinki had reached Moscow.

The United States embassy reported that the Finnish government had asked American good offices in the Russo-Finnish dispute. Some sources believed the reply would be delayed until Russia had dispatched a "victor" to the Finnish front.
