AS the war in western Europe entered its fifth month this week, the prime fact about it remained negative: The failure of death to ride the skyways with any such tactical civilians was being neutralized to expert.

For this, neutral strategists have cited a variety of reasons. Most compelling, perhaps, are fears of retaliation—and political considerations: lingering peace hopes, and a hesitancy to outrage League opinion.
