Under a blue north light the rich colors of tobacco appear. Tobacco is sorted into two main divisions, a brown-yellow color called "L" and a light green color called "V". The two main color grades are further subdivided into several grades of leaf.

In closely inspected In the sorting room there is one inspector for each five girls and above the inspector there is one chief inspector for each group.

Due to such factors as texture, moisture and coloring, which affect the grading of the leaves, all leaves are inspected after they are sorted and tobacco of experience to become uniformly mature in grading good tobacco.

Packed into Bales After four to six weeks of this, the tobacco is packed into bales of 160 pounds each, using a grass matting cover which is imported from Sumatra. The tobacco will still continue to "work" or ferment to the bales for another month before it is ready for shipment.
