Curb Stocks Sweden Seeks Faster Planes

Asks War and State Department to Release Late-Type Craft.

New York, Feb. 16.—The government of Sweden has been in conversation with the American War and State Department in an effort to obtain the release for export of late-type, high altitude fighters. "A considerable number."
