Being a young and ignorant nation and therefore essentially optimistic people, we are very apt to close our eyes quite deliberately against all facts which strike us as unpleasant. It is pleasant to come across that bit of sound common sense.

But as General Gamelin, the philosopher king in command of the French armies, so wisely remarked the other day, "There is no use getting angry at a fact which will not change. For they won't in the least case until you happen to think about them, and therefore they won't change, but they will remain just as unpleasant as before."

If we want to live intelligently and constructively during these years of crisis, we should follow the government's advice. And when we listen to the easy optimism about "right away" provisions, we should remember that "right away" means "right away" for the rich and the powerful, and "right away" for the poor and the powerless.

During the last three thousand years of written history, we have accumulated so much data upon the problem of "self-government" that we have pushed into the background all the very old and very wise ideas of the ancients.

It has been one of the bitterest of our experiences that we have found, and the end is by no means in sight.

Roosevelt Asserts Census Controversy Political Act

He did not remember talking with
Dougherty.

Washington, March 6.—The census controversy swept from Capitol Hill to the White House and back again today, with President Roosevelt describing efforts to strike out personal income questions as "a political act."

Asked about the Democratic senatorial content in Pennsylvania, he said he knew nothing of it because he had just returned from a cruise. He made the same reply to a question as to whether he would withdraw his name from the Pennsylvania presidential primary.

The president expressed the hope that Senator Donahay (D., Ohio), would reconsider his decision to retire from public life and would run either for senator or governor.

Meanwhile, Senator Chaves (D., N. M.) told reporters that it would be "better for the interests of the Democratic party and the nation" if Mr. Roosevelt would disclose his plans. Chaves declined to say whether he favored a third term.

Agrees Talk Politician
In discussing the census situation with reporters, Senator Barkley (D., Ky.) said he agreed with Mr. Roosevelt that the talk of revising the questionnaire was political in the event the Senate approves Mr. Roosevelt's resolution and the income questions are deleted.

Under the voluntary plan, the questions would not be asked by census takers but would be mailed to all citizens. They could either return the answers postage-free or through the quarters in the waste-basket.

That is only a second line of defense, remarked Senator Lee (D., Okla.), a member of the Senate group. "We are hopeful the Roosevelt resolution will be defeated when the committee acts on it next Tuesday."

Need To Reach Lowest Group
Lee said the voluntary procedure "would be better" because many persons in the lowest income brackets would ignore the questionnaires. "That is the group we need to reach," he said.

"Toby called this procedure 'a political act' and said that the president was 'outdriving himself in a purely legislative matter.'"

The president added jokingly that Senator Byrnes had voted to delay action for a week. A reporter called attention to a census question, "Have you ever been divorced?" 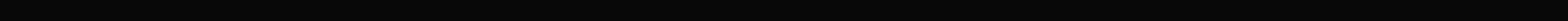

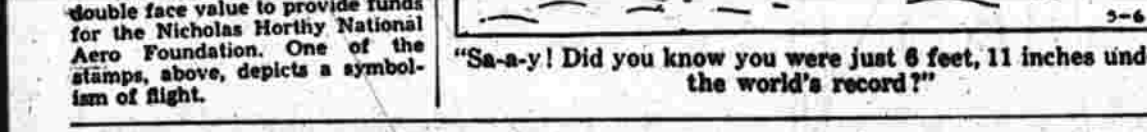
