Dependent Mother Murders Daughters, Slashes Own Throat

Broad Brook Resident Dies 13 Hours Later in Rockville Hospital; Had Been in Ill Health; Was Temporally Inane; Father in Church

In the tub and her feet over the side. Not being able to find his wife who came with her husband occupy the upper part of the house. As Mrs. Lettice came into the home she heard a noise in the cellar. Both went to the cellar. In some corner was Mrs. Egglevich kneeling as though in prayer, all holding the knife. This was taken from her by her husband and she was carried to the upper part of the house.

The woman was in a serious condition, but conscious. Dr. W. J. Robinson was called. He was carried in a short time and at once called in the ambulance. The injured woman was taken to the Rockville City Hospital in the ambulance. Three times on the way to the hospital it was necessary to stop while the doctor applied clamps to stop the flow of blood.

Dr. Robinson had telephoned Mrs. Lettice and she was taken to the hospital as she was given a blood transfusion. Dr. Robinson was called. He was carried in a short time and at once called in the ambulance.

At the home in Broad Brook, the mother and her two daughters were found in the kitchen. The mother was holding a knife over the head of one of the girls. The other girl was lying on the floor. The mother had slashed her own throat.

Scenes of Triple Broad Brook Tragedy

At the Rockville hospital the case was marked closed by the police. Mrs. Lettice was on her investigation the state police checked the actions of the husband. It was found that he was at mass at the time. There was nothing on the clothes or hands of Mr. Egglevich to show that he was in any way implicated. His record as a citizen of Broad Brook was unimpaired. He served in the United States for four years during the World War and in addition to being employed by the Rockville City of tobacco warehouses and in the fields, he also grew a few acres of tobacco of his own near his home.

Level There 23 Years Mrs. Lettice was 23 years of age when she married her husband. He has been in the home since the day she was married. He was a good father and a good husband. He was well liked by her neighbors. When the family in the upper part of the house heard cries of "Help, Help," Mrs. Lettice went to the scene and Policemen J. L. Cavanaugh, R. H. Wirtala and J. A. Prentice responded to the call. They did not think it was anything serious. They thought the two girls were fooling.

At the police report, they found both men unconscious, with broken household articles strewn about. Mrs. Lettice was in the back yard, according to the report. She was seen by the police. 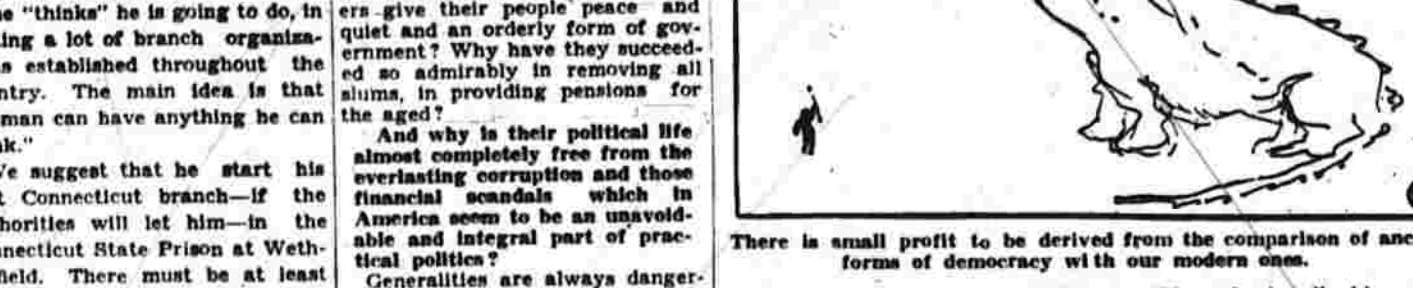

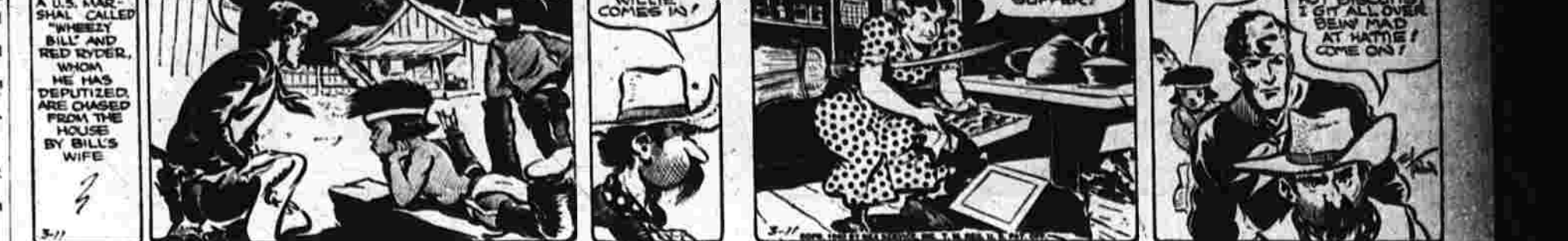
