Ergo, the French must be figuring on some pretty extensive use of troops mounted on animals—some good steel sources of supply of cavalry mounts in North Africa, and at home, so large parades in this country might be taken as points to a decisive battle more than just a few thousand mounted troops.

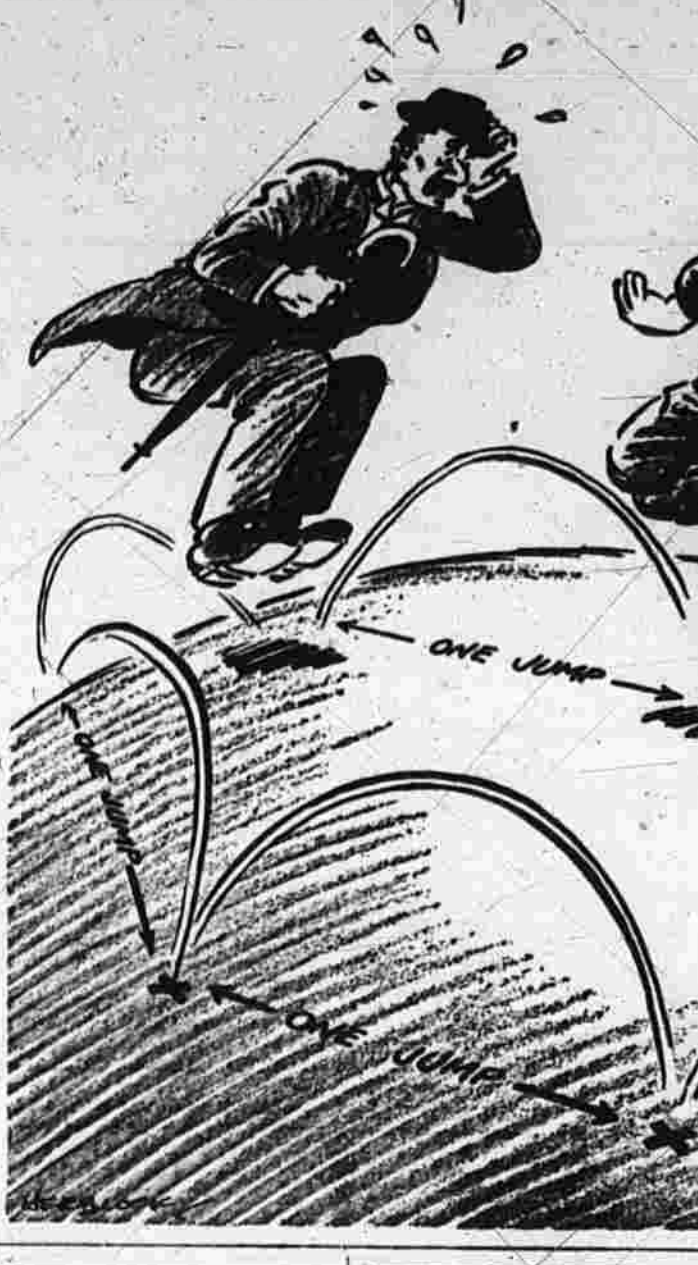
