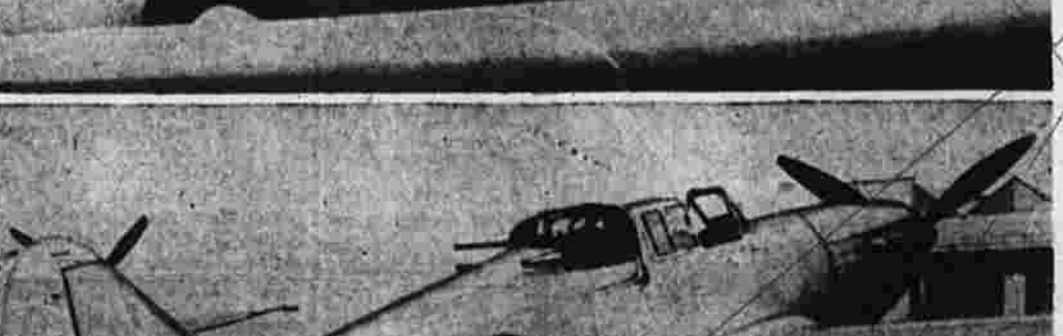

### School Board Scans New Budget Figures

May Be a Little Over \$1,000 More Than the Budget of Last Year; The Figures.

The tentative budget for schools for the coming year, considered at the meeting of the School Board of the city of Manchester, Conn., last night, will be slightly in excess of the budget of the year now closing, with some further details to be checked. The final figures will not be perfected until late in June, after the school board meeting over the budget.

In going over the figures the board decided that there would be sufficient left from the budget to allow for the installation of a new oil burning heating system in the Robertson school and although the cost of oil will be higher than was the case last year, due to the war, there will be about the same amount recommended for this year. There has been a saving in the cost of the electric lighting made in the rate, as was done in the last year.

The tentative budget will mean an expenditure of \$1,000 which is a little over \$1,000 more than was the estimate last year. It shows an increase of \$6,000 in teachers' salaries but there is a saving of \$4,000 over the estimate of installing a new oil burner in the Central High School.

There will be slight increases in the general control account which was decided to advance the salary of Miss Florence Williams from \$1,600 to \$1,800 and to give her the title of executive secretary to the superintendent. But this will not make much difference in this account. The big item is teachers' salaries, due to increase given each year. Janitors are given a slight increase, but there was a slight saving made by the employment of a new janitor to fill the vacancy in the Buckland School. There will be no pay for insurance this coming year and a saving of \$600 is made in this account. The big item of saving is the special appropriation that was made last year to install oil burners, which amounted to \$4,000. This year the amount is \$3,400.

New School Room With the money that is still in the appropriation it will be possible to install a new heating system in the Robertson school in North School street at a cost of \$500 for the changes and add one more teacher to that school. The estimated increase in the teachers' salary budget.

Teacher Transfers. The first business before the meeting was attended by Chairman George R. Keith, secretary, Lillian Rowley, Sarah Healey, Robert H. Smith, Everett McElroy and Ludwig Hansen, who was the recommendation made for Mrs. Leona Neveer, who has taught the first three grades in the Kenney street school for three years, to be transferred to teach Grade I in the Robertson school made vacant by the resignation of Mrs. Dorothy Hansen. Mrs. Neveer has taught Grade V in the Washington school and was recommended for transfer to her home.

The public has been hearing much in recent months about the "job-training" program that is being carried on in trade schools throughout the state to supply industry with skilled labor, and tonight of Manchester will have an opportunity to obtain first-hand information on the project at the "Open House" which will be held by the local State Trade school tomorrow night.

Director J. G. Edmanson, in extending an invitation to the public to visit the school between the hours of 7 and 9 o'clock tomorrow evening, said that the students who are enrolled in the 200-hour "job-training" course will have their classes in session along with the classes of the regular student body. All departments will be in operation and visitors are urged to ask as many questions as they wish about the school and its various courses in the trades.

The school orchestra, directed by William J. Hanna, will present a concert in the assembly hall during the evening.

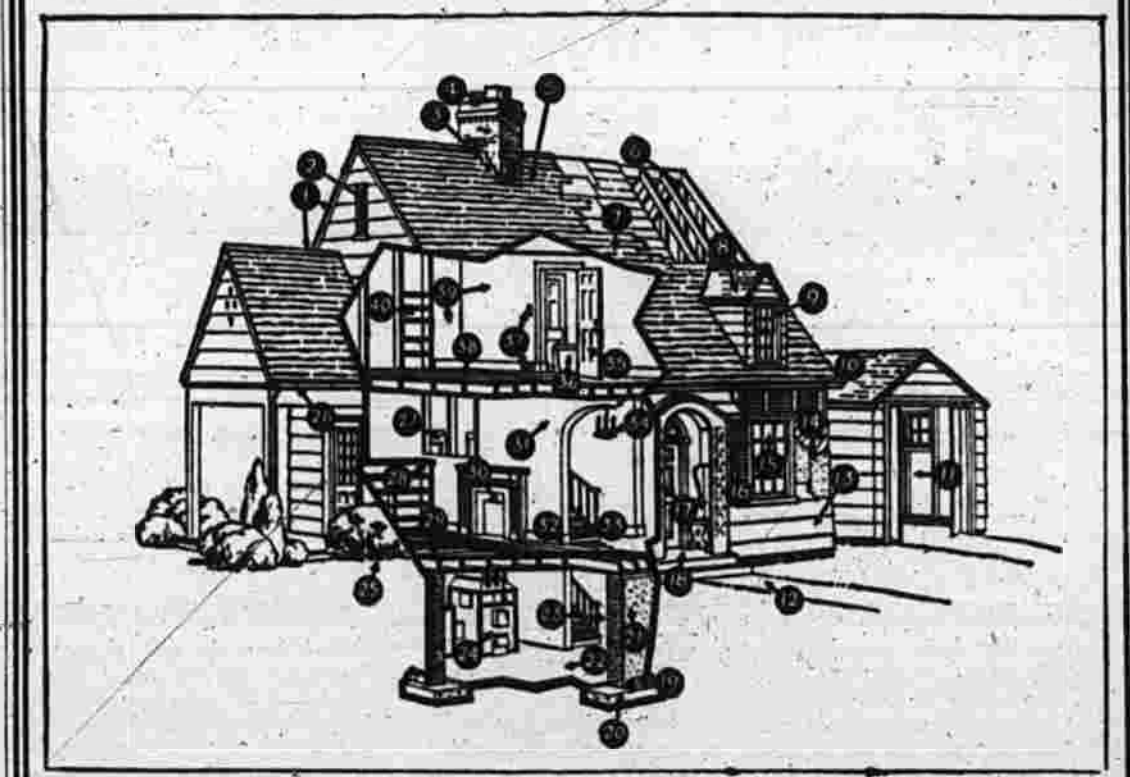

### HOW to BEAT the HEAT

By Alice H. Smith, Nutritional, Cleveland Health Council

What! You can't eat that? How often are you troubled— or think you're troubled—by your food combinations? Are you sure you can't mix your cereals and your starches? Do you have to eat your vegetables in the "natural" state?

You can't mix your starches and proteins? "Oh, I never do that," you hear someone say. Carefully that person avoids roast beef and mashed potatoes, or broiled fish and a glass of milk at the same meal. Yet that same person will smack his lips at the mention of oyster steak, lobster a la Newburg, codfish cakes, or baked beans and Boston brown bread. All combinations of starch and proteins.

The trouble with your stomach is often mostly in your head. Nature, fortunately, has the food-mixing problem worked out well in hand. Milk, for example, contains both sugar (lactose) and protein. Likewise all cereals contain both protein and starch; also vegetables.

But your food is "toxic," you say. "Normally, food isn't toxic. That's one thing to remember next time you begin to worry about food combinations. Of course, there are some people with definite allergies, and to them certain foods are toxic. These obviously should be avoided. A physician should advise in such cases. But generally, were you to avoid several foods because they were "toxic," you would run the danger of diet deficiency which might result in trouble much worse than sensitive or allergic reactions. The same holds true for "acid" foods. Normal, healthy people and citrus fruits do not cause an "acid" condition. The acids in these foods are normally burned or oxidized and their residues are alkaline.

### General Health Affects Teeth

Chicago—(AP)—Research workers have discovered that some mouth diseases are often caused by poor general health, rather than purely local invasion of bacteria. Dr. Herman Beckus of San Francisco told the Chicago Dental Society recently.

Such tissue-damaging diseases as pyorrhea and trench mouth may be due to deep-seated systemic disturbances, he said.

Dr. Beckus, an associate professor of dental medicine at the University of California, said he has found that the connective tissues around the teeth are sensitive to the influence of the sympathetic nervous system, the circulatory system and to general disturbances of metabolism.

"Bridge" for illnesses. These provide a "bridge" over which many bodily illnesses reach the gums, he explained.

He reported that his study of 80 patients afflicted with one type of pyorrhea, complete physical examinations revealed that only three were completely healthy except for the mouth disease.

The others exhibited some form of glandular ailment, intestinal disturbances, toxic material in the blood or deficiencies of minerals or vitamins.

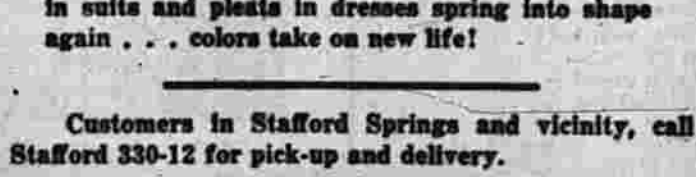

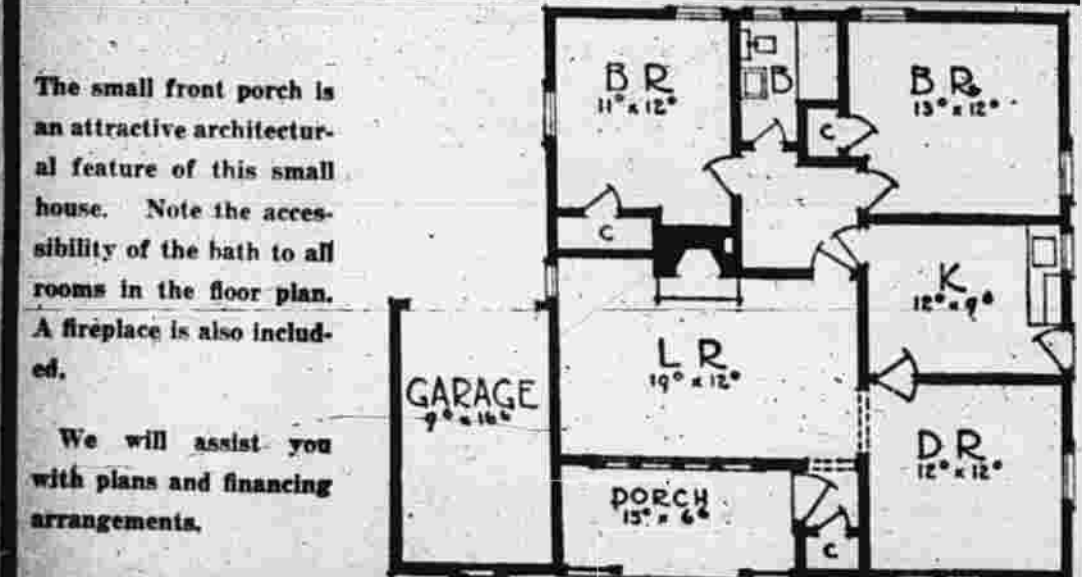
