PRICE PAID BY GERMANS

Bitter Fighting Ends In Flanders Battle

Price Paid by Germans and Losses Suffered by Allies Obscured by Conflicting Claims.

By The Associated Press. Conclusion of the great battle of Flanders, signalled by the fall of Dunkerque yesterday, left the Germans in complete possession of all Holland, Belgium and approximately 10,000 square miles of the Meuse river valley.

The price paid by the Germans for their lightning conquest and the losses suffered by the Allies are obscured by conflicting claims that neutral military experts agree that the cost to both sides in men and materials has been enormous.

Comatose. The Germans estimate Allied dead and wounded at between 600,000 and 700,000 men and places their own dead at 200,000 and wounded at 450,000.

Naval Losses. The British have acknowledged the loss of six destroyers and 23 minor naval vessels in the withdrawal from Dunkerque and the French have admitted the loss of 10 destroyers.

London, June 4.—Lawrence O'Shaughnessy, a noted Harley street heart surgeon, has been killed in Flanders, where he served with the Royal Army Medical Corps.

O'Shaughnessy, who specialized in heart operations for many years, was credited with discoveries described as important in surgical treatment.

He used a treatment for grafting onto the heart a tissue which was said to give new strength to ailing people suffering from cardiac trouble.

URGE GENERAL

Tax Revision Bill to Yield \$1,000,000,000 Annually Is Being Prepared.

Washington, June 5.—Ordinance with predictions that a \$1,000,000,000 tax boost would mean a broadening of the income tax base, Republican House members were reported today to be insisting on a general revision of the revenue laws.

A bill to yield \$1,000,000,000 annually, or nearly that sum, for defense expenditures was being prepared in the House Ways and Means Committee with the implied approval of President Roosevelt.

Temporary schedule thus far determined merely would increase existing levies. Entrance into some new brackets, however, was strongly indicated.

A wide-open revision of all taxes, which Republicans were describing as desirable, would require months and would keep Congress in session indefinitely.

All but one of the Republican committee members abstained from voting yesterday when the Ways and Means Committee decided to recommend increasing the Federal debt limit from \$45,000,000,000 to \$49,000,000,000 and to devise revenue increases which would "at least" pay off this \$4,000,000,000 boost in five years.

One suggestion before the committee was that the exemption for married persons be lowered from \$2,500 to \$1,500 and for single persons from \$1,000 to \$500.

The committee's present plan would require increasing the Federal debt limit to \$49,000,000,000 beyond the original administration proposal of \$45,000,000,000.
