

Exercise Halts Blood Clotting

Method Reported Effective Aid in Minimizing Surgical Risks.

Chicago.—A new way to prevent blood clots and the fatal blocking of veins following operations—by using bicycle pedals—was announced recently.

The method was reported as an effective aid in minimizing one of the greatest risks of surgery, the danger of post-operative complications.

It consists of elevating the foot of the patient's bed from 24 to 48 hours after a major operation and then having the patient exercise on ordinary bicycle pedals mounted on the foot of the bed.

To Avoid Obstruction. The pedal-yr-way-to health exercise, described in a report of The American Medical Association, is designed to help avoid blood vessel obstruction by stimulating retarded circulation.

Dr. Cass de Tréville, Dr. Joseph H. Jester, both of Chicago, reported that this exercise and elevation of the bed helps promote the flow of blood back to the heart.

Retarded flow and stagnation sometimes causes the formation of coagulated plugs or clots in a blood vessel or in a heart cavity, which can result in the blocking of a blood vessel by a clot.
