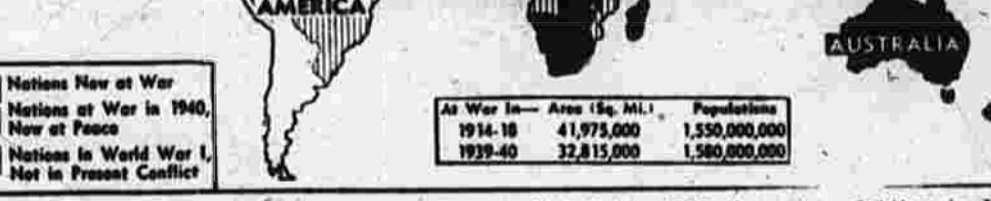

Berlin, June 18.—A great part of Europe—eight formerly independent nations and now probably Germany—must find a place for itself in Germany's totalitarian economic and industrial scheme as a result of German conquest and war.

Argentina May Buy All Public Utilities

Buenos Aires, June 18.—(AP)—Proposition of all foreign-owned public utilities companies is proposed in a bill introduced in the Argentine Senate by Senator Matias Sanchez Sorondo...

The measure would authorize a government bond issue of 1,500,000 pesos (about \$400,000,000) to identify foreign concerns.

At the same time it was reported by reliable sources that the government was planning to propose expenditure of 400,000,000 pesos (about \$100,000,000) for purchase of additional material for the Army and Navy.

The government already has initiated steps to increase the Air Force by the purchase of 400 planes and some anti-aircraft weapons.

568-Pound Man Seeks To Reduce His Weight

Kansas City, Kas., June 18.—Tom Grinick, 27, weighs 568 pounds. He asked University of Kansas hospital physicians to reduce him.

He said he "got alone first at 300 and 400 pounds—going to dances and all" but gained 115 the past seven months and this "made it rather unendurable."

The physicians said Grinick was suffering from a gland ailment called hypothyroidism. They put him in a reinforced bed and said they hoped to cut off 300 pounds within a year.

They will feed him gland extracts and a special diet.

Egyptian Minister Quits Rome Early

Rome, June 18.—(AP)—Mourad El Ahmed Pasha, Egyptian minister to Rome, left Italy two days ago for Switzerland after informing Italian officials that his government had severed diplomatic relations with a legion spokesman today.

The minister's unannounced departure was a surprise to the American embassy, which had arranged to take over Egyptian affairs. He was originally scheduled to leave today or tomorrow with the legion staff to be exchanged in Greece or Turkey for Italian diplomats en route home from Cairo.

The Egyptian legation said the minister had left Rome on a "leave of absence." Arrangements for departure of his staff remained in doubt.

Mexico Plans Army Change

Mexico City, June 18.—(AP)—The Mexican government began preparation today of a compulsory military service law which President Lazaro Cardenas said would be presented soon to a special session of Congress.

Approval of the government plan, which Cardenas announced last night, was regarded as certain in the pro-administration Congress.

Although no date for the special session was fixed, political circles mentioned July 10—four days after the presidential elections—as a likely choice.

Other Defense Steps: In addition to compulsory military service, Cardenas urged that the army reserve and a supreme defense council be established.

The president, in a statement, asserted that the present situation in the United States "is a source of concern to the Mexican people."

Informed quarters related Cardenas' move as a gesture to strengthen Mexican relations with the United States.

The government recently has expressed its friendship for its big northern neighbor and its sympathy for France.
