Uruguay, Investigating Possibility on Nazi Plan to Revolt, Cheers Tale Warship Coming.

Montevideo, June 25.—(AP)—The 10,000-ton U. S. cruiser Quincy stayed overnight in Montevideo harbor today and anxious Uruguayans investigating possibility of a Nazi-pledged revolt, cheered the news that a second U. S. warship is on the way.

Orders from Washington to keep the Quincy here and word that the seventh squadron flagship Wichita will arrive Saturday from Rio de Janeiro within a few hours after the Chamber of Deputies met in secret session last night to stamp out subversive activities.

Three other units of the U. S. war fleet, the battleships Arkansas, Colorado and New York, were expected to arrive in Montevideo tonight at La Guaira, the port for Caracas, Venezuela. They were expected to arrive in Montevideo with a large party of midshipmen aboard.

Observers in Montevideo interpreted the presence of the Quincy and expected arrival of the Wichita as a sign that the United States would back up the government in whatever safeguards are adopted.

There has been concern that Germany might take reprisals if the United States were to send a special commission's report that Argentina, influenced from abroad, planned to set up a little Nazi state in this vulnerable section of South America.

There was speculation that the arrival of the Wichita, bringing the 1918 fleet which had been ordered to sea by the United States, might signal the start of a new phase in the battle for England.

Berlin, June 25.—(AP)—Germany's population which for six weeks has watched anxiously yet confidently the progress of the battle in France cheered the conclusion of that war today and waited for the next phase—the Battle for England.

Italy's high command announced today that hostilities against France ceased on land and sea and in the air at 1:30 a. m. today (6:30 p. m. Monday) according to the terms of the armistice, and that it would continue up to a victory over Germany.

Gen. Heinrich Von Stuebeling was named chairman of the Italian high command. The fighting in France had ceased at 1:30 a. m. today, the end, the high command said, the Germans had continued their advance, reaching Royat, at the mouth of the Gironde, on the Atlantic coast, and Angoulême.

In Loraine and on the Rhine, the communiques reported, France lost additional fortifications. Some 25,000 French soldiers were taken to the Donon in the Vosges, and southwest of Lyon, St. Etienne and Auvergne.

Italy's triumph 14-day war with France was one which the French had promised would break the chain which confines us to our sea in the Mediterranean.

The official Italian news agency reported that troops on the frontier with France stopped firing precisely at 1:30 a. m. today (6:30 p. m. Monday) in accordance with German-French terms of the armistice.
