### Plans Planes Three Times As Large as Big Bombers

Washington, July 29.—The Army Air Corps disclosed today that it is planning for future airplanes three times as large as its present huge four-engines bombers.

Such planes, each big enough to fill a football field and as high as a ten-story building, may not be flying for another year or ten, but aeronautical engineers declared that they would be ready.

The bigger you build them the more efficient they are, one engineer declared.

**Completing Testing Plant**

The Air Corps now is completing at Wright Field, Dayton, Ohio, a power plant laboratory designed to test engines up to 4,000 horsepower, using propellers 40 feet in diameter.

The largest present twin-engine aircraft engines develop a maximum of 2,000 horsepower, and average automobile engines run less than 100 horsepower. The largest propeller blades now in use on large bombers or transport airplanes are about 16 feet in diameter.

Five years ago the absolute limit in engine power was believed to be about 800 horsepower, but the figure went steadily up to the present 2,000 horsepower.

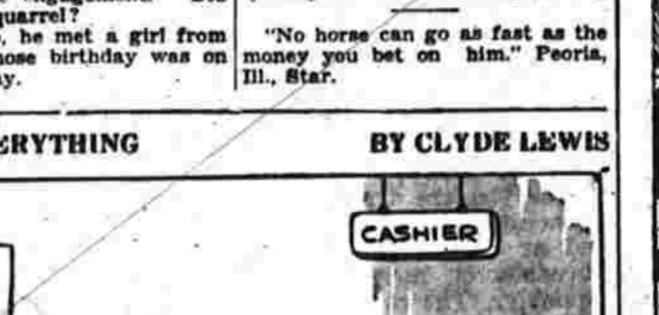

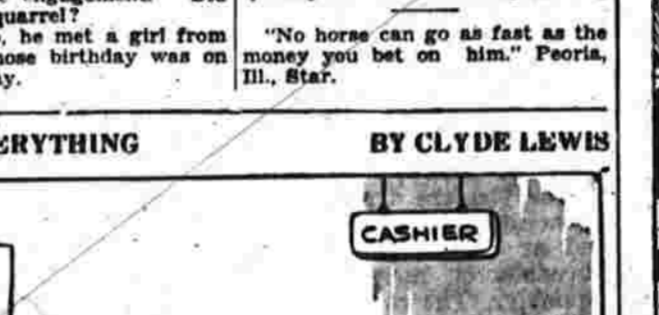
