Pine Acres is Nearing Half-Completed Mark

Large Development Attracting Many Out-of-Town Residents to Be Home Owners Here.

With one house completed and being used as a model demonstration home and with seven others so far along as to assure their completion by the end of the week, there are now under construction in Pine Acres, new real estate development south of Center street, 23 houses of the 63 that are eventually to be built.

Of the 32 under construction 11 have been built. The remaining 21 have been purchased by the property owners. Others have been reserved for out-of-town buyers and farther away points being the present homes of the owners.

Excavating More

Today excavation was started for five houses that will face on Center street. There will be 14 houses in all on the north side of Center street when the work is finished. The houses that are nearly completed are on the north side of Chester drive. There are to be nine houses on the north side of Chester Drive and four on the south side. The reason that there are fewer houses on the south side is due to the plan to have a grass plot circle that will divide Chester Drive from the north side. Thomas Drive enters the property from the center of the north side of the development and is connected with Center Drive, which is the roadway to the end of the development. Carol drive extends from Center street through to Olcott street.

Demonstration Home

The house that will be used as a demonstration home, and furnished has not been sold, as it is being used as a demonstration home. It has four rooms with a detached garage. It stands on a lot 100 feet front and 120 feet deep. The house rooms are all on one floor. There is a living room, a kitchen, a dining room and a tiled bathroom with a built-in bathtub and shower. There is a medicine chest in the bathroom. In each of the four rooms of the house there are four separate electric light outlets. The heat is by an oil burning furnace with a hot water attachment to provide hot water in the heating system. There is a storage tank 300 gallons of water in the cellar and two sets of stairs.

All of the lumber for the house already built has been furnished by the William J. Kinnegan Company. The heating has been installed by Johnson and Little and the plumbing by Anderson and Johnson.

The concrete foundations and sidewalks have been laid by Sylvester and Aceto of Manchester and the work that is now being done in laying of the sanitary sewer is being done by Byrd and Fitzgerald. William L. Fitzgerald has his power shovel working on digging the sewer line.

Long Sewer Line

There is a sewer line of 3-inch sanitary sewer pipe. When work was first started on the development it was thought possible to make connection with the sanitary sewer line of the town. Four separate lines were started before it was found possible to connect this with the main line of a right of way from Olcott street.

Federal Check Is Made Here

All Persons Connected With Operating Radio Must Be Citizens.
