Expert Economists See America Gaining Benefits from Gold

New York, Aug. 11.—How rich is there gold in America?

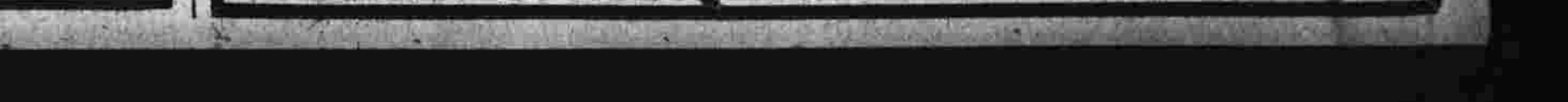
