Local Resident Seriously Hurt

Lawrence Copeland Sustains Concussion of Brain; Hit by Auto.

Lawrence B. Copeland, 41, of 14 Hackmatack street, is in a critical condition at the Manchester Memorial hospital as the result of being struck by an automobile at the junction of South Main and Hackmatack streets Saturday afternoon. He suffered a concussion of the brain and had unconsciousness from the time he entered the hospital until this morning. His condition is still reported critical by Dr. Edwin C. Higgins, who is attending him.

Returning from work Mr. Copeland is employed by the Rogers Paper Manufacturing Company at its Goodyear plant and was returning home from work Saturday afternoon when the accident happened. He was just about to cross South Main street from the east side of the street when, according to witnesses, he was struck by an automobile driven by John Kinkhader, 23, of New Haven, who is at present making his home at 121 Summit street.

Carried several feet from the east side of the street, he was struck by Officer Herman Muskie. The automobile was being driven north on South Main street. There is a down grade at the point where the accident took place and it is believed that the car was carrying several feet before being thrown to the side of the road. While the head injury was the most serious, Copeland also sustained injuries to his left side and to his hip. Examinations made

Dr. Melvin Warrah, head of the Pierce county hospital, infantile paralysis ward, estimates the Terhaar lung will save thousands of lives annually because of its extreme mobility.

The new respirator looks like the chest protector of a suit of armor. Rubber sheets fit tightly at the waist and arms of the paraplegic victim, sealing in the precious respiratory air. It works on the same principle as the "bolter" for the patient.
