London, Sept. 20.—(AP)—The British Admiralty reported today the torpedo sinking of a 10,000-ton German troop transport in a burst of smoke and flames, adding belated support to reports that nearly all of 4,000 men aboard were lost. 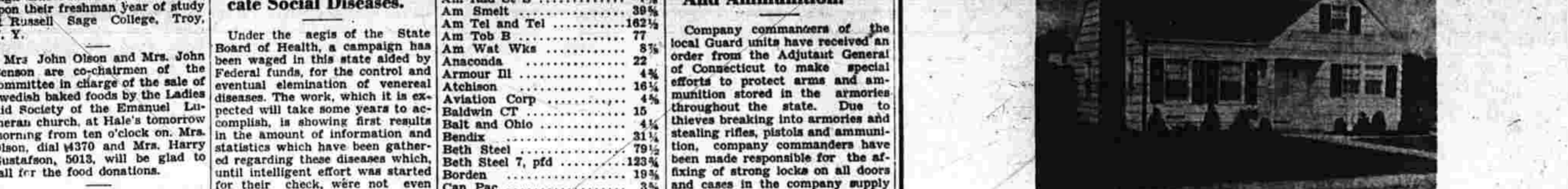

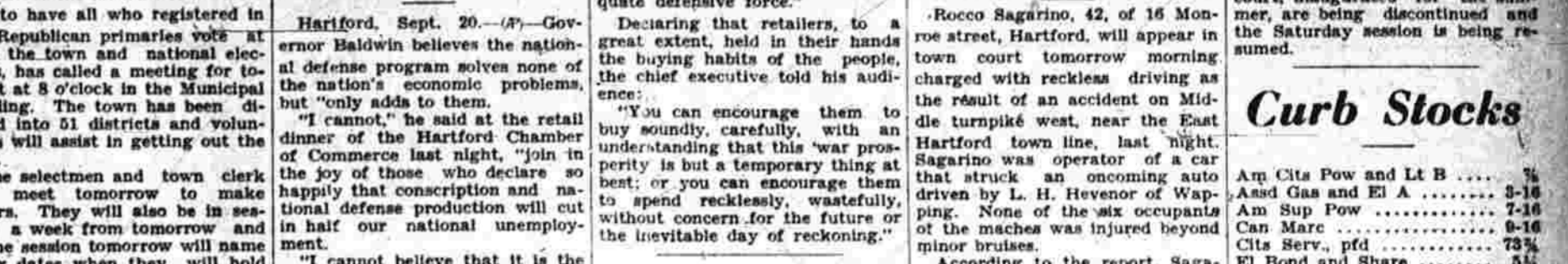
