Record Total Of New Voters

1,250 Made in Town, 566 Republicans and 532 Democrats.

An all time record for new local voters was made at the three elections held from September 21 to 9 o'clock Saturday night when 1,254 new voters were made. This was 700 more than was estimated by the press and 250 more than the high vote made in 1932 when voters made 532 declaring themselves as Democrats. This left 150 unpledged. It was the largest gain in Democratic voters ever made in one year in the town's history. Of the 1,254 voters made, 637 were women and 617 men.

Getting Late Ready The registrar worked yesterday getting the new names listed and arranged to meet the voters at the printers today. The town will have a new voting list for the election. The list contained 11,177 names. Of this number 10,101 were men and 1,076 women. Allowing for the removal from town and death from the list, plus the new voters made in the session a week ago Saturday last Wednesday and again last Saturday, the list will contain over 12,000 names.

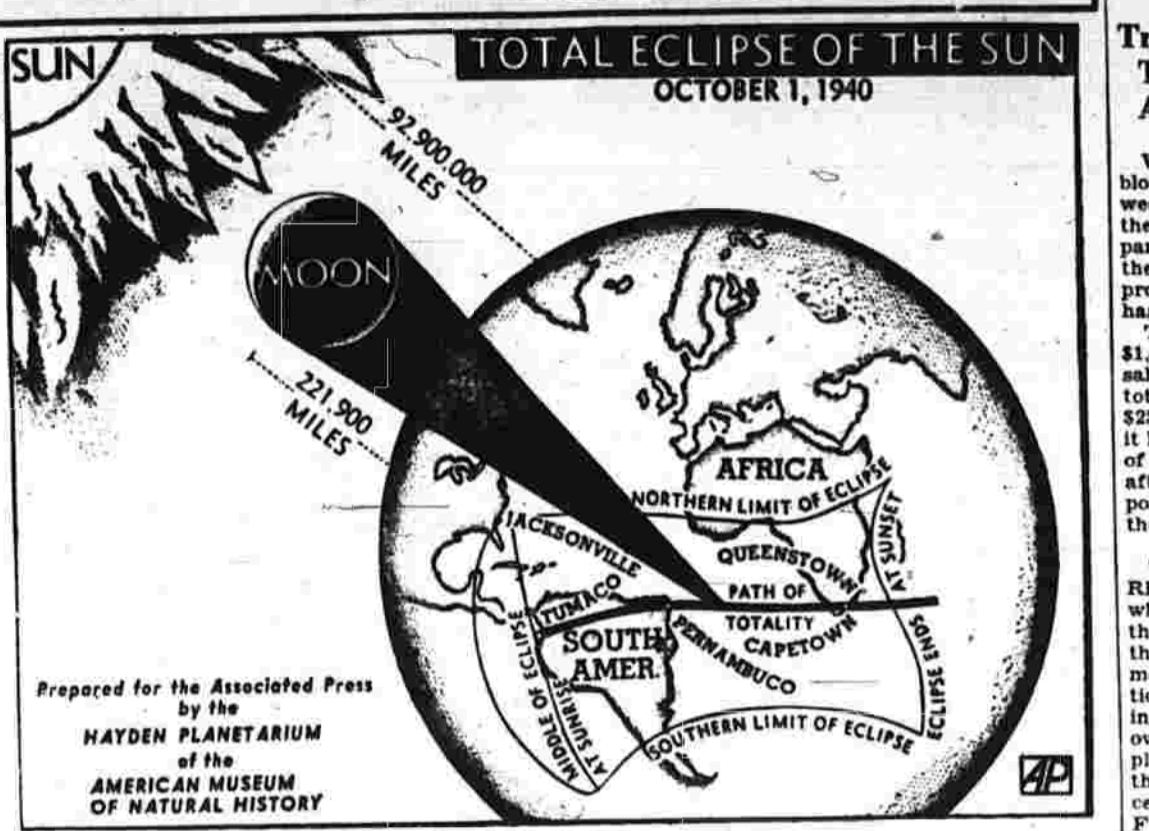
