London, Nov. 15.—(AP)—A thousand persons lay dead or injured and great fires swept Friday through the ruins of Coventry—the work of massed German bombers who raided the ancient industrial city with fire and blast bombs last night. Many free still burned fiercely this morning and firemen were working against overwhelming odds. Unaccounted townspeople still were buried in great piles of rubble, so thick and tangled that the work of rescue was held up.
