Extra Expense

But last year the amount was \$1,200 for \$500 as salary for the treasurer of the district has never been paid in the past.

7,018 Workers Placed in Jobs

State Employment Service Establishes October Record.

Hartford, Nov. 22.—(AP)—The Connecticut State Employment Service established the greatest October record in the history of the service last month when jobs were found for 7,018 workers in private industry, State Labor Commissioner Corneilus J. Dana announced today. The percentage increase of October represents an increase of 17 per cent over the 5,968 placements in September and an increase of 20.5 per cent over the 5,821 for October last year.
