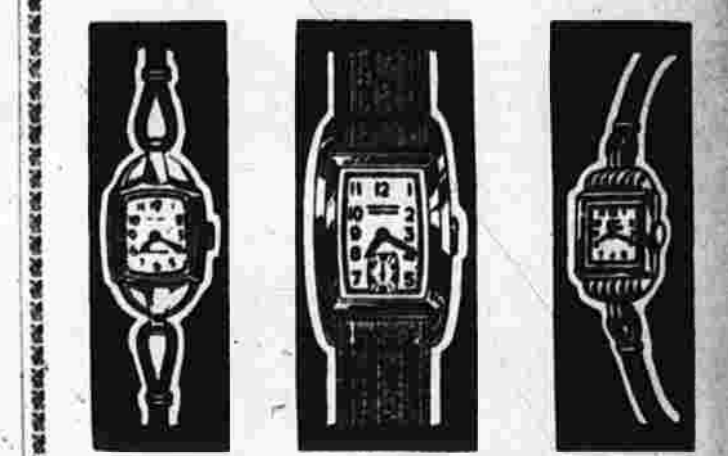

Personal Levy Boost Urged Taft Would Increase Tax On Incomes from Four To 10 Per Cent.

Washington, Dec. 18.—(AP)—Senator Taft (R., Ohio) suggested today that the first step in heavy personal income tax should be to increase the normal levy from four per cent to 10 per cent.

Taft declared that personal income was the "most promising source of revenue" and added that a Federal sales tax should not be imposed until increased taxes on personal income had been tried.

He said that "we would only be fooling ourselves" if an effort to increase taxes on corporations, "taxes on business are passed on to the people," he continued, "but they tend to discourage business activity."

Message to Heavy Leverage

Pointing out that the people of Great Britain had managed to pay off a national debt of \$100,000,000,000, he said that "the people might as well pay at least 10 per cent on their income as pay 4 per cent."

He added that present excise, or "nuisance," taxes were "a burden on the people" and that "the government should be contented with the 4 per cent normal tax rate."
